



### 8. MENU OPERATION 8.1 PAIRING THE CAMERA AND PARENT UNITS

8.3 TEMPERATURE UNIT SETTING

2. Press the ◀ key or ▶ key until the temperature icon (⑥) is highlighted;

3. Press ▲ key or ▼ key to select between °F or °C;

4. Press OK key to confirm
5. Press the key to Exit.

Note: The detection range is 0~50 °C.

8.3.1 TEMPERATURE ALARM SETTING

When the temperature goes above or below the settings, the temperature icon turns red. It will flash to alert user by audio beeps. Press any key on the parent unit to stop beeping and flashing.
