Wireless Handheld Monopod Extendable Selfie Stick for iPhone & Android

Instructions for use:

At first use: Pair the mobile device and Selfie Stick with your mobile device's Bluetooth function. First turn on the Selfie Stick. Next, turn on the mobile device's Bluetooth function and search for selfie device. Connect your device with the Selfie Stick. Your device should now be paired.

Step 1: Place mobile phone into the phone holder

Step 2: Turn camera app on and reverse camera so front camera is in use

Step 3: Adjust the top to the angle desired

Step 4: Extend the selfie stick

Step 5: Capture desired picture and press the button on Selfie Stick

Step 6: Enjoy your awesome selfies!

Charging Selfie Stick:

Step 1: Insert mini USB into bottom of Selfie Stick

Step 2: Insert the USB into a USB charging device (wall USB port, car USB port, computer)
