I am an engineer from SGS(SZ) test lab. I got a project to apply FCC certification. Please find attached for the user manual and picture of the sample. The sample contains left earphone, right earphone and charge docking

My questions are:

1. Can I use one ID number for the project?
2. Can I locate the label in the bottom of the docking?

If I need to use two ID number, Can I locate both of their label in the bottom of the docking?

FCC response on 11/30/2016

Please provide photo's (labeled) for each device.
Also, clarify if there is a transmitter in each component.

---Reply from Customer on 11/30/2016---

Dear Sir/Madam,

The right earphone has Bluetooth and NFMI(10.579MHz) transmitter, while the left one just has NFMI

transmitter. The docking is for charging (no transmitter) purpose only. The client wants to locate the label in the bottom of the docking. Please advice. Thanks.

FCC response on 12/01/2016

The left and right earplugs are different transmitter and require separate FCC identifiers.
The docking station with not transmitter, is subject to Verification assuming it has digital circuitry.
The FCC identifiers cannot go on the docking station.
The FCC identifier for each earplug must go on the device unless you provide justification that it is not possible.

---Reply from Customer on 12/07/2016---

Dear Sir/Madam,

Please find attached for explanation about the impractical reason to locate the label in the earplug.

FCC response on 12/08/2016

The justification must be formal letter and signed by the grantee.
It should also state that there are no other markings(besides the FCC ID) because of no room on the earplugs or otherwise explain. Thanks.

---Reply from Customer on 12/11/2016---

Dear Sir/Madam,

Please find attached for formal letter from grantee and please help to advice if it is ok to locate the label in the charge docking. Thanks.

FCC response on 12/12/2016

The FCC identifiers can go in the manual not on the docking station. The attestation request needs to be revised accordingly.
