
802.11n (20) TEST RESULTTEST PLOT OF BANDWIDTH FOR LOW CHANNEL

Owing to satisfy the requirements of the number of measurement points, we set the RBW=1MHz, VBW>RBW, scan up through 10th harmonic, and consider the tested results as the worst case, if the tested results conform to the requirement, we can deem that the real tested results(set the RBW=100KHz, VBW>RBW) are conform to the requirement.







TEST PLOT OF OUT OF BAND EMISSIONS THE WORST CASE OF 802.11b FOR MODULATION IN HIGH CHANNEL



















TEST PLOT OF OUT OF BAND EMISSIONS THE WORST CASE OF 802.11g FOR MODULATION IN HIGH CHANNEL










TEST PLOT OF SPECTRAL DENSITY FOR MIDDLE CHANNEL




TEST PLOT OF SPECTRAL DENSITY FOR HIGH CHANNEL





TEST PLOT OF SPECTRAL DENSITY FOR MIDDLE CHANNEL




TEST PLOT OF SPECTRAL DENSITY FOR HIGH CHANNEL




802.11n 20 TEST RESULTTEST PLOT OF SPECTRAL DENSITY FOR LOW CHANNEL

11. RADIATED EMISSION

11.1. MEASUREMENT PROCEDURE


1. The EUT was placed on the top of the turntable 0.8 or 1.5 meter above ground. The phase center of the receiving antenna mounted on the top of a height-variable antenna tower was placed 3 meters far away from the turntable.

- 2. Power on the EUT and all the supporting units. The turntable was rotated by 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation.
- 3. The height of the broadband receiving antenna was varied between one meter and four meters above ground to find the maximum emissions field strength of both horizontal and vertical polarization.
- 4. For each suspected emissions, the antenna tower was scan (from 1 M to 4 M) and then the turntable was rotated (from 0 degree to 360 degrees) to find the maximum reading.
- 5. Set the test-receiver system to Peak or CISPR quasi-peak Detect Function with specified bandwidth under Maximum Hold Mode.
- 6. For emissions above 1GHz, use 1MHz VBW and RBW for peak reading. Then 1MHz RBW and 10Hz VBW for average reading in spectrum analyzer. Place the measurement antenna away from each area of the EUT determined to be a source of emissions at the specified measurement distance, while keeping the measurement antenna aimed at the source of emissions at each frequency of significant emissions, with polarization oriented for maximum response. The measurement antenna may have to be higher or lower than the EUT, depending on the radiation pattern of the emission and staying aimed at the emission source for receiving the maximum signal. The final measurement antenna elevation shall be that which maximizes the emissions. The measurement antenna elevation for maximum emissions shall be restricted to a range of heights of from 1 m to 4 m above the ground or reference ground plane.
- 7. When the radiated emissions limits are expressed in terms of the average value of the emissions, and pulsed operation is employed, the measurement field strength shall be determined by averaging over one complete pulse train, including blanking intervals, as long as the pulse train does not exceed 0.1 seconds. As an alternative (provided the transmitter operates for longer than 0.1 seconds) or in cases where the pulse train exceeds 0.1 seconds, the measured field strength shall be determined from the average absolute voltage during a 0.1 second interval during which the field strength is at its maximum values.
- 8.If the emissions level of the EUT in peak mode was 3 dB lower than the average limit specified, then testing will be stopped and peak values of EUT will be reported, otherwise, the emissions which do not have 3 dB margin will be repeated one by one using the quasi-peak method for below 1GHz.
- 9. For testing above 1GHz, the emissions level of the EUT in peak mode was lower than average limit (that means the emissions level in peak mode also complies with the limit in average mode), then testing will be stopped and peak values of EUT will be reported, otherwise, the emissions will be measured in average mode again and reported.
- 10. In case the emission is lower than 30MHz, loop antenna has to be used for measurement and the recorded data should be QP measured by receiver. High Low scan is not required in this case.




Radiated Emission Test-Setup Frequency Below 30MHz

FCC RADIATED EMISSION TEST SETUP ABOVE 1GHZ






