
Rave Light Up Bluetooth Speaker Instruction Manual SM-3965

Pairing name: Rave



Function Key:

- 1. ON/OFF switch
- 2. LED light switch
- 3. Play forward/Volume Up
- 4. Play/Pause/Answer Calls/Redial
- 5. Play back/Volume Down
- 6. MIC
- 7. AUX in
- 8. Bluetooth/Recharging indicator
- 9. Power Input Port

Operation:

- Press and hold the ON/OFF switch (1) for two seconds to choose POWER ON/OFF.
 Device enters BT pairing mode automatically.
- Single press Play forward/Volume Up (3) one time to select the next song, press and hold (3) for two seconds to increase volume.
- Single press (4) to Play/Pause/Answer Calls/Redial mode.
- Single press Play back/Volume Up to select the last song, press and hold for 2 seconds to decrease volume.
