

Setup / Basic Operation

Remove white protective needle cover by gently pulling towards front of unit. Remove any packaging materials from the unit. Connect the power adaptor to a wall outlet. The power adaptor is located in the cabinet box -It is strongly recommended that this product should be operated only from the type of power source indicated on the marking label.

Basic Operation Push the POWER button to turn the unit on. Select the source by turning the selection knob (PHONO/AUX/CD/FM/BT) 3. Rotate the VOLUME knob to adjust to the desired sound level.

-To prevent interference, avoid bundling audio signal cables together with the AC power cord.

Listening through RCA LINE OUT For amplifier device listening, first reduce the volume level to minimum. Compact Disc Handling



The stylus should last about 50 hours under normal use. However, it is recommended that the stylus be replaced as soon as you notice a change in sound quality. Prolonged use of a worn-out stylus may damage the record. The highest speed of 78 RPM records would wear
