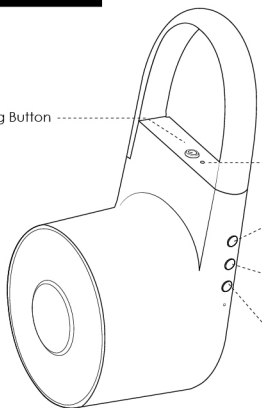

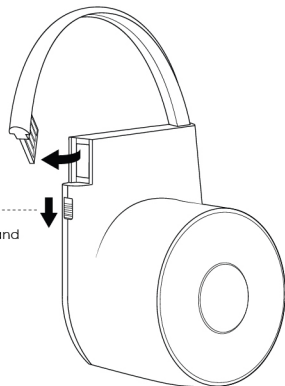

FCC Statement
