# Operate the device

### Connect to the network

- There are two ways to connect to network one is by Ethernet another is by Wi-Fi. When first time use Wi-Fi you need to set up the Wi-Fi.
- 1. Click 'Settings'.







Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1. If you do not see the LED lights, check the power if connected well.
- 2. If the LED light is bright and the TV is turned on but TV screen doesn't show TV box interface, please check whether the HDMI is connected well, or check weather the TV video output has been switched to HDMI output.
- 3. If you can not see mouse icon on TV screen, please check whether the mouse is connected well, if you use 2,4G wireless mouse, please make sure it has battery inside. (Some of the mouses do not match the TV box due to non-standard, please consult the
