

7.1 20 dB bandwidth

7.1.1 General

This test was performed to measure the 20dB bandwidth of the transmitter hopping channel. Specification test limits are given in Table 7.1.1.

- 7.1.2.1 The EUT was set up as shown in Figure 7.1.1, energized and its proper operation was checked.
- **7.1.2.2** The EUT was set to transmit modulated carrier at maximum data rate.
- **7.1.2.3** The transmitter bandwidth was measured with spectrum analyzer as frequency delta between reference points on modulation envelope and provided in Table 7.1.2 and associated plot.
- **7.1.2.4** The test was repeated for each data rate and each modulation format.



Plot 7.1.1 The 20 dB bandwidth test result at low frequency





7.1 Carrier frequency separation

7.1.1 General

This test was performed to measure frequency separation between the peaks of adjacent channels. Specification test limits are given in Table 7.1.1.

7.1.2 Test procedure

- **7.1.2.1** The EUT was set up as shown in Figure 7.1.1, energized with frequency hopping function enabled and its proper operation was checked.
- **7.1.2.2** The spectrum analyzer span was set to capture the carrier frequency and both of adjacent channels, the lower and the higher. The resolution bandwidth was set wider than 1 % of the frequency span.
- **7.1.2.3** The spectrum analyzer was set in max hold mode and allowed trace to stabilize.
- **7.1.2.4** The frequency separation between the peaks of adjacent channels was measured as provided in Table 7.1.2 and associated plots.



7.2 Number of hopping frequencies

7.2.1 General

This test was performed to calculate the number of hopping frequencies used by the EUT. Specification test limits are given in Table 7.2.1.

7.2.2 Test procedure

- **7.2.2.1** The EUT was set up as shown in Figure 7.2.1, energized with frequency hopping function enabled and its proper operation was checked.
- **7.2.2.2** Initially the spectrum analyzer span was set equal to frequency band of operation and the resolution bandwidth was set wider than 1 % of the frequency span. If the separate hopping channels were not clearly resolved the frequency band of operation was broken to sections and the resolution bandwidth was set wider than 1 % of the frequency span of each section.
- 7.2.2.3 The spectrum analyzer was set in max hold mode and allowed trace to stabilize.
- **7.2.2.4** The number of frequency hopping channels was calculated as provided in Table 7.2.2 and associated plots.







7.3.2 Test procedure

- **7.3.2.1** The EUT was set up as shown in Figure 7.3.1, energized with frequency hopping function enabled and its proper operation was checked.
- **7.3.2.2** The spectrum analyzer span was set to zero centered on a hopping channel.
- **7.3.2.3** The single transmission duration and period were measured with oscilloscope.
- **7.3.2.4** The average time of occupancy was calculated as the single transmission time multiplied by the investigated period and divided by the single transmission period.
- **7.3.2.5** The test was repeated at each data rate and modulation type as provided in Table 7.3.2 and associated plots.



Plot 7.3.1 Single transmission duration



7.4.1 General

This test was performed to measure the maximum peak output power radiated by transmitter. Specification test limits are given in Table 7.4.1.

7.4.2 Test procedure

- 7.4.2.1 The EUT was set up as shown in Figure 7.4.1, energized and its proper operation was checked.
- 7.4.2.2 The EUT was adjusted to produce maximum available to end user RF output power.
- **7.4.2.3** The frequency span of spectrum analyzer was set approximately 5 times wider than 20 dB bandwidth of the EUT and the resolution bandwidth was set wider than 20 dB bandwidth of the EUT. To find maximum radiation the turntable was rotated 360° and the measuring antenna height was swept in both vertical and horizontal polarizations.
- 7.4.2.4 The maximum field strength of the EUT carrier frequency was measured as provided in
- 7.4.2.5 Table 7.4.2 and associated plots.
- **7.4.2.6** The maximum peak output power was calculated from the field strength of carrier as follows:

$$P = (E \times d)^2 / (30 \times G)$$

where P is the peak output power in W, E is the field strength in V/m, d is the test distance and G is the transmitter numeric antenna gain over an isotropic radiator.

The above equation was converted in logarithmic units for 3 m test distance:

Peak output power in dBm = Field strength in dB(μ V/m) - Transmitter antenna gain in dBi – 95.2 dB







Plot 7.4.1 Field strength of carrier at low frequency




Plot 7.4.2 Field strength of carrier at mid frequency

Figure 7.5.1 Setup for spurious emission field strength measurements below 30 MHz






Figure 7.5.2 Setup for spurious emission field strength measurements from 30 to 1000 MHz



Plot 7.5.1 Radiated emission measurements from 9 to 30 MHz at the low carrier frequency













Plot 7.5.5 Radiated emission measurements from 30 to 1000 MHz at the mid carrier frequency







Figure 7.6.1 Setup for spurious emission field strength measurements below 30 MHz






Figure 7.6.2 Setup for spurious emission field strength measurements from 30 to 1000 MHz






Plot 7.6.2 Radiated emission measurements from 30 to 1000 MHz






Plot 7.6.4 Radiated emission measurements from 3000 to 18000 MHz



- 7.7.2.1 The EUT was set up as shown in Figure 7.5.1, energized and the performance check was conducted.
- **7.7.2.2** The specified frequency range was investigated with antenna connected to spectrum analyzer/ EMI receiver. To find maximum radiation the turntable was rotated 360⁰ and the measuring antenna was rotated around its vertical axis.
- 7.7.2.3 The worst test results (the lowest margins) were recorded and shown in the associated plots.

7.7.3 Test procedure for spurious emission field strength measurements above 30 MHz

- 7.7.3.1 The EUT was set up as shown in Figure 7.5.2, Figure 1.1.3, energized and the performance check was conducted.
- **7.7.3.2** The specified frequency range was investigated with antenna connected to spectrum analyzer/ EMI receiver. To find maximum radiation the turntable was rotated 360°, the measuring antenna height was changed from 1 to 4 m, its polarization was switched from vertical to horizontal.
- 7.7.3.3 The worst test results (the lowest margins) were recorded and shown in the associated plots.

Figure 7.7.1 Setup for spurious emission field strength measurements below 30 MHz






Figure 7.7.2 Setup for spurious emission field strength measurements from 30 to 1000 MHz



Plot 7.7.1 Radiated emission measurements from 9k to 30 MHz at the low carrier frequency









7.8.2 Test procedure

- **7.8.2.1** The EUT was set up as shown in Figure 7.8.1, energized normally modulated at the maximum data rate with its hopping function disabled and its proper operation was checked.
- **7.8.2.2** The EUT was adjusted to produce maximum available to end user RF output power at the lowest carrier frequency.
- **7.8.2.3** The spectrum analyzer span was set to capture the carrier frequency and associated modulation products. The resolution bandwidth was set wider than 1 % of the frequency span.
- **7.8.2.4** The spectrum analyzer was set in max hold mode and allowed trace to stabilize. The highest emission level within the authorized band was measured.
- **7.8.2.5** The maximum band edge emission and modulation product outside of the band were measured as provided in Table 7.8.2 and associated plots and referenced to the highest emission level measured within the authorized band.
- **7.8.2.6** The above procedure was repeated with the EUT adjusted to produce maximum RF output power at the highest carrier frequency.
- **7.8.2.7** The above procedure was repeated with the frequency hopping function enabled.





Plot 7.8.1 The highest band edge emission at low carrier frequency with hopping function disabled




Plot 7.8.2 The highest band edge emission at high carrier frequency with hopping function disabled





7.9 Antenna requirements

The EUT was verified for compliance with antenna requirements. A transmitter shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party will be used with the device. It may be either permanently attached or employs a unique antenna connector for every antenna proposed for use with the EUT. This requirement does not apply to professionally installed transmitters.
