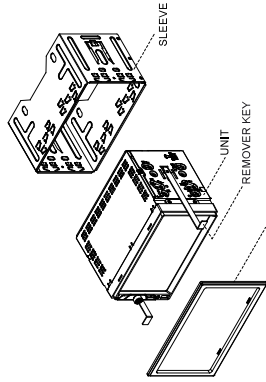

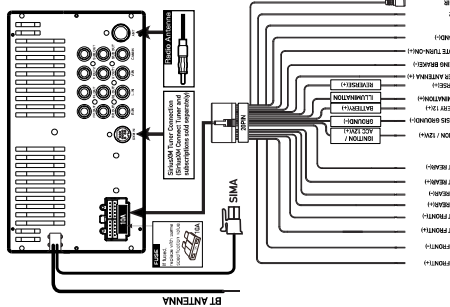

Main Menu

In main menu, press the desired icon to enter the corresponding mode: Radio, SiriusXM[™], USB Screen Mirroring, SD Card, BT Phone, BT Music, Camera, Aux In, AV In, Settings.

Radio Operation

Select the Radio icon from the Main Menu screen or press MODE until Tuner is selected.

SiriusXM[™] Operation

- 1. Band
Displays SiriusXM[™] radio band currently selected. Preset channels are available: SM4, SM7, SM12, and SM25.
- 2. Search
Press this icon to search channels by category.
- 3. Channel List
Press this icon to see the preset channels per band.
- 4. Live channel
Go to Live channel.
- 5. Channel Up
Press this icon to select station forward manually.
- 6. Channel Down
Press this icon to select station backward manually.
- 7. Skip forward
Tap this icon to skip to the beginning of the current song or prior songs. Press and hold to fast-rewind.
- 8. Pause
Press this icon to pause the audio.
- 9. Skip backward
Tap this icon to skip to the beginning of the current song or prior songs.
- 10. Preset
Press and hold to add the current channel to a preset. Tap to recall the preset.
- 11. Content Info
Press Song icon to cycle through song, content info and description link.

General Operation

- Press the function icons to select in Settings
- 1. Screen Dimmer
 - 2. Voice Activation
 - 3. Audio
 - 4. Nav/ hot button
 - 5. Settings

Audio Operation

- Press Sound Effect icon to setup menu to select Preset, 7-band tone control, Surround and Balance.
- 1. EQ Setting
 - 2. Surround Setting
 - 3. Balance

Screen Operation

In Settings menu press one of options to adjust the screen condition.



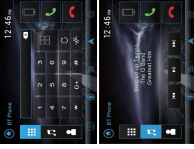
Speaker Zone Operation

- Zone 1 Button
Press Zone 1 to turn the sound from Zone 1 on or off.
- Zone 2 Button
Press Zone 2 to turn the sound from Zone 2 on or off.

Bluetooth Operation

The microphone is hidden in the receiver.

Pairing and Connecting
Make sure that Bluetooth is activated on your device before you begin the pairing process. The AVM700UI will automatically discover and pair with devices that are currently connected. Complete the pairing sequences from your Bluetooth device. The device name is "AVM700UI". The unit can be in any mode of operation when pairing is performed. On certain phones, pairing may need to be done more than once.



- Dialing a Number**
Press **DISK** to connect a call, and press **NUM** to end a call.
- Making and Ending a Call**
Press **NUM** to transfer audio between the head unit and mobile phone.
- Streaming Audio**
Press **MUSIC** to play or pause the music.
- Press **DISK** to go back to the previous track.
- Press **NUM** to advance to the next track.

Voice Activation Operation

Bluetooth should be paired between your smartphone and the receiver. Press the voice activation button **VA** and the receiver will switch into Bluetooth mode. This will activate Siri[®] or Google Assistant[™] on your smartphone. You will need to manually switch back to the previous or desired mode once this operation is terminated.

On-screen Nav/ App Operation

Activation of Axxera Smart App should not be asked, but open on your smartphone for this operation. Touching **VA** will guide you instant access to your favorite navigation App on your smartphone. Please refer to the complete manual on www.axxeraaudio.com/support/manuals.php.

APP Operation

The Axxera Smart App is the ultimate wireless remote control for your AVM700UI receiver. You can download Axxera Smart App from Apple App Store or Google Play Store and install it on your smartphone or tablet. Please scan the following QR code to download Axxera iRig P1 App to your smart phone.
