




TYPICAL FRONT-LOAD DIN MOUNTING METHOD



# Main Menu






# **Tuner Operation**

Select the Tuner icon from the Main Menu screen or press MODE unit Tuner is selected.

- 2. Preset Scan
- 3. Presets

#### USB/iPod Operations

Press the USB to select in Main menu.

#### iPhone iPod Mode Setting method

- 1. When iPhone is not connected to XDCP97BT using the cable
- 2. Select iPod Setting Mode
- 3. Select Restrictions in General mode (Enter 0000 if the password is required)
- 4. Inactivate the CarPlay item

FYI, in case of iPod nano and Classic, these does not include CarPlay function so iPod cable is connected then they will work as iPod mode.






#### General Operation

# **Audio Operation**

Press Sound Effect icon In setup menu to select Fader and Balance, 10-Band tone control, Presets \ EQ Control (Classic, Rock, Pop, Jazz, Beat, Flat, User), Surround (Stadium, Cinema, Opera House, Karst Cave).








#### CarPlay Operation

Select CarPlay on the Main Menu.

If the iPhone is connected via USB port, press CarPlay icon on main menu to mirror the iPhone's apps onto the screeen. And If the iPhone USB cable is inserted to the USB port then the XDCP97BT will automatically change to CarPlay



## **Bluetooth Operation**

#### **Bluetooth Microphone**

The microphone is External to the receiver.

#### **Pairing and Connecting**

Before you can use a Bluetooth device, it must be paired and connected. The Multi Media broadcasts the pairing signal constantly when no devices are currently connected. Complete the pairing sequence from your Bluetooth device. The device name is "XDCP97BT". Once pairing is complete, most Bluetooth will

connect automatically if the device is in range when the unit is powered-on.

# **Dialing a Number**

Press to display keypad and dial a number

#### Making and Ending a Call

Press \( \text{to connect a call, and press } \bullet \text{to} end a call.


# **Transfering Audio**

Press ( to transfer audio between the head unit and mobile phone.

#### **Streaming Audio**

Press I to play or pause the music.

Press | to skip to the previous track. Press to advance to the next track.
