- 在第一次使用无线头戴耳机之前，请确保使用 5V 24W 或更低功率的充电器为其充电。

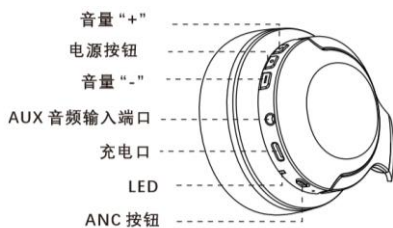
无线头戴耳机与手机配对

1. 长按电源按钮 2 秒，会听到“开机”的提示音，同时LED灯会变红/蓝色并交替闪烁。
2. 打开手机，进入“设置”页面，打开蓝牙，找到“JHM-A1”点击进行配对连接。
3. 配对成功后，下次开启耳机，将会自动连接到手机。

恢复出厂设置

当耳机已开机但不与手机配对时，可快速按 5 次电源按钮恢复出厂设置，耳机即可正常连接使用。

Things to keep in mind with Wireless Headphone

- Wireless Headphone should not be used in extreme temperatures.
- Before using the headphones for the first time, make sure to charge them using a 5V, 24W or lower USB-C charger.

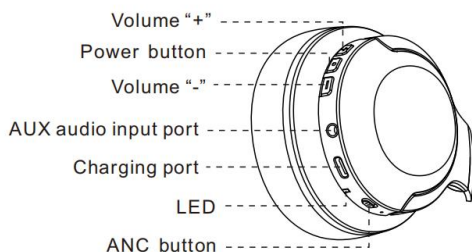
Pairing Wireless Headphone with your phone

1. Turn on the headphones by pressing the POWER button for 2 seconds. You'll then hear a "Power-on" notification and the LED will flash blue and red alternately.
2. On your phone, go to Settings, turn Bluetooth on, and then pair with "JHM-A1". Check your phone user guide to find out how to access Bluetooth settings.
3. Once paired, the headphones will automatically connect to your phone whenever you turn on the headphones.

Performing a factory reset

When the headphones are on and not pairing with your phone, press power button quickly for 5 times to complete the factory reset.

Power button	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Press and hold (for 2 seconds) to turn the headphones on. • Press and hold (for 3 seconds) to turn the headphones off. • Press quickly (for 2 times) to redial the last number • Press quickly (for 3 times) to turn Voice Assistant on. • Press briefly to pause or resume playback. • Press briefly to answer or end the call. • Press and hold (for 2 seconds) to decline the call.
Volume"+"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Press and hold (for 2 seconds) to play the next song. • Press briefly to increase the volume.
Volume"-"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Press and hold (for 2 seconds) to play the previous song. • Press briefly to decrease the volume.
