To Whom It May Concern,

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Federal Communications Commission (the “Commission”) rules (47CFR§§0.457, 0.459), Plume Design, Inc. (“Plume”) respectfully requests that the Commission withhold the following documents from public disclosure indefinitely.

- **Tune-up Procedure**


The above-mentioned documents contain detailed system and equipment descriptions and constitute proprietary information related to the operation of the equipment. The public disclosure of the above documents could be harmful to Plume and would give competitor an unfair advantage in the market.

In additional to above mentioned documents, pursuant to Public Notice DA 04-1705 of the Commission’ s policy, in order to comply with the marketing regulations in 47 CFR §2.803 and the importation rules in 47 CFR §2.1204, while ensuring that business sensitive information remains confidential until the actual marketing of newly authorized devices, Plume respectfully requests that the Commission withhold the following documents for 180 days after the grant of equipment authorization is issued:

- **Test Setup Photos**

It is our understanding that all measurement test reports in FCC ID label format cannot be granted confidential treatment and, therefore, we understand that such information will be available for public review once the grant of equipment authorization is issued.
