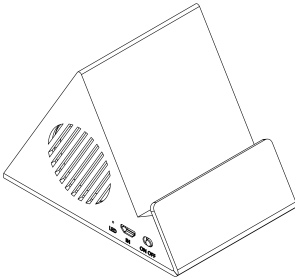

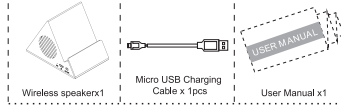

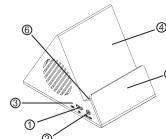

Operating Instruction

1. Pairing with mobile phone

Slide switch to the left to turn on wireless speaker, You will hear a tone

Turn on the Bluetooth function of the mobile phone, Search for the accessible Bluetooth devices and select 'M30 or M30W' from the device list to Pair, the mobile phone will show 'connected' if the phone is paired with wireless speaker, and you will hear a tone. Then you can play music from mobile phone and listen to music from wireless speaker.

2. Charging wireless speaker

Insert the Micro USB charging cable to speaker's micro USB port, insert the other end to the USB port of DC5V charger, Red LED will light up when charging. Light off when fully charged.

Note: When the speaker's voice is lower than normal conditions or heard a warning tone, please charge the speaker in time.

3. Wireless charging device (Optional)

1) Insert the Micro USB charging cable we provided to speaker's micro USB port, insert the other end to the USB port of DC5V charger.

2) Put the phone on the wireless charging area and make sure their center is aligned.

Note: Make sure your phone is fit for Qi standard receiving equipment.



1. Connect the power supply

2. Place the phone in the wireless charging area

3. Start charging

Warm Tips

1. Do not charge the speaker with other unsuitable power adaptors. It may cause damage to the speaker. The speaker must be charged properly by USB ports or by a AC/DC adapter with output DC5V.

2. In order to avoid damage to your hearing and prolong the speaker's use-life, please do not listen to music for long time in high volume environment.

3. When a fault occurs, please immediately turn off the power switch, unplug the USB plug, prevent speaker and other components damaged.

4. Over use of battery will affect the wireless distance and use-life, please charging in time.

FAQs

1) Why is there no sound when the speaker is turned on?

A: Make sure that you have charged the battery fully for the first time. Charging time is approx 3 hours.

2) Why is there no sound when playing the speaker?

A: Check the speaker is connected by your phone. If there is no connection, please reconnect and make sure your phone have connected the properly Speaker.

3) How to recognize the Bluetooth speaker is fully charged?

A: When the speaker is being charged, and the red indicator is automatically turned off, It is already fully charged.
