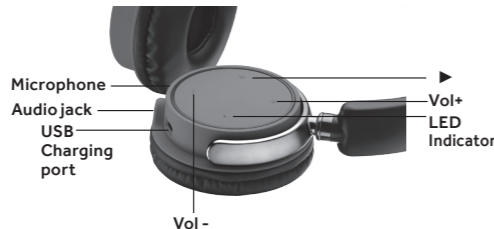

Charge Your Headphones



When the **LED Indicator** flashes red or has no response, charge your headset.

- Normal charging takes about 1.5 hours.
 - Provides up to 12 hours of play time and up to 100 hours standby.
1. Connect the supplied charging cable to the USB source and to the micro **USB charging port**. The **LED Indicator**

lights red when charging and turns off when fully charged.

2. Unplug the charging cable when the headphones are fully charged.

Pairing

1. Press and hold **▶** for 5 seconds to turn on. **LED Indicator** flashes pink and then blue quickly.
2. Press and hold **▶** for 3 seconds to start pairing. **LED Indicator** flashes blue and red.
3. On your device, turn on the Bluetooth function, and set it to search for Bluetooth devices.
4. Select **AUVIO BTCHP** from the list of found devices.
5. When paired, the **LED Indicator** flashes blue slowly.

Note: If the headphones are not paired within 3 minutes, they turn off automatically.

Using the headphones

To turn the headset on/off, press and hold **▶** for 5 seconds.

On: **LED Indicator** flashes pink and then blue quickly.

Off: **LED Indicator** flashes pink and then turns off.

Start Bluetooth pairing	▶	..and hold for 3 sec.

Go to next/previous track	Vol +/-	..and hold for 3 sec.

Clear Bluetooth Pairing

Your headphones automatically reconnect to the most recently paired device when switched on.

If you want to clear the Bluetooth memory, change to other Bluetooth devices, or in case of problems with pairing, do the following:

1. Press **▶** and hold for 3 seconds.
2. The headphones beep to confirm disconnection. **LED Indicator** turns from flashing blue slowly to rapidly flashing blue and red.
3. When you switch on the headphones next time, the headphones no longer pair automatically.

Wired Mode

- Use the **3.5mm Audio Cable** to connect to your headphones's audio jack. Make sure the headphones are switched off to save power. A handy option when your headphone battery power is depleted.
