



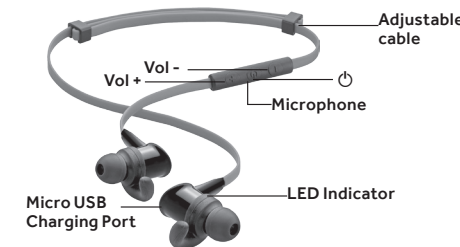

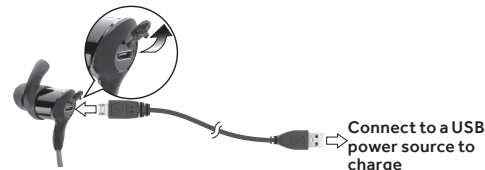


Charge Your Headset

When the headset indicator flashes red or has no response, charge your headset.

- Normal charging takes about two hours.
- Provides up to 5 hours of play time and up to 150 hours standby.

1. The **LED Indicator** lights red when charging and turns blue when fully charged.
2. Unplug the charging cable when the headset is fully charged.

Pairing

1. Press and hold the **Power** button for 7 seconds to enter pairing mode. A voice says "Pairing". The **LED Indicator** flashes red and blue as your headset searches for Bluetooth-enabled devices.
2. Follow the instructions for your Bluetooth-enabled device to pair with the headset. Select and connect to the device called **AUVIO BTSH**. When paired, a voice says "Your headset is connected". The **LED Indicator** flashes blue every 4 seconds and the headset enters standby mode.

Note:

- If your Bluetooth-enabled device(s) are out of connection range and disconnect, move back within 3 minutes to reconnect automatically.

Using the Headset

To turn the headset on/off, press and hold the **Power** button for 3 seconds.

On: **LED Indicator** flashes blue and red. A voice says "power on".

Off: **LED Indicator** flashes red 3 times. A voice says "power off".

Calls

Answer or end a call	Power	Press briefly, or use the phone keys
Reject a call		Press and hold for 2 seconds
Redial the last called number		Press twice quickly
Toggle a call between your headset and your connected phone		Press and hold for 2 seconds
Answer a second call during a call		Press twice quickly
Answer a second call and end the current call		Press briefly
Mute or unmute during a call	Vol +	Press and hold for 2 seconds
Adjust volume	Vol +/-	≥1

Play/Pause	Power	x1
Previous Track	Vol -	Hold for 3 seconds
Next Track	Vol +	
Adjust volume	Vol +/-	≥1

Note: The button functions may vary depending on your device and phone's protocol and devices.

Changing Bluetooth Devices

Your headset automatically reconnects to the most recently paired device when it is powered on.

To pair a new device, you must disconnect the current device's Bluetooth functions first. See your Bluetooth device's instructions for details.
