




- Pull off the plug before doing the maintenance.

Clean up the wires and sundries on the ground in case of being tangled into wheels and brushes.







Charging station should be against the wall and flat place, or else the function will be influenced.

* Forbid the children to play the poly bag, or else it will cause smother.


1.4 About Battery

The machine will only be used with the original battery.


1.6 Exception Clause





* There is a battery, two side brushes and a filter assembled in main body, and another two side brushes and one filter is inside.



3.Product Installation

3.1 Installation and Removal of Main Body Battery




1. Loosen the screws on the battery cover with a screwdriver and open the cover.

2. Wiring Method: Take out the connectors of the battery and the cleaner first, and then join them according to the corresponding color direction.

Unwiring Method: Unplug the terminal of battery line in the reverse direction.

3. Put the battery into the compartment as per the direction shown in the figure first, and then place the well-arranged terminals and wires into the space. Finally put the cover on and lock it with screws.

3.2 Installation of Charging Station




1. Place the charging base on the flat ground that is perpendicular to the wall. There is no obstacle within the range of 3 meters in length and 1 meter in width. Press the charging base with force to make it more firmly pasted on the floor. After plugging in the adapter, insert the DC plug into the DC port.

2. Connect the Adapter to the Docking Station and the power supply. Sort out the connecting cable of the adapter carefully to make the cleaner wound when it works.


\Box Tips:

The docking station can 't be placed on the carpet. It is recommended to place it at a fixed position for a long time. Please don 't move the docking station artificially during the cleaning.


3.2 Installation of Remote Control



1. Open the battery cover.



3. After installing the battery, turn on the power switch of the cleaner. Check whether the remote control can control the cleaner. In case of no reaction, refer to Recoding the Remote Control Code on Page 12.




2. Place two AAA (#7) batteries into the compartment.






1、Standby State

The sufficient power of the cleaner shall be ensured. Long press power button till indicator will light; release it and the cleaner will enter standby mode.



2、Auto Cleaning

The cleaner in the standby state, press the Power Button and the cleaner will start auto cleaning



3、Auto Recharge

The cleaner in the standby state, press the power button 2 times and the device will start operation and the green indicator flash to enter the recharge mode.




- * Please don 't control the device during its operation in order to ensure the work efficiency.

5	Charging	Green LED indicator	recharge on the dook station.
6	Fully Charged	Green light on	The battery is fully charged.
7	Error	The red light is on or flickers and the buzzer sounds.	The device is abnormal or fails.
8	Coding	The buzzer sounds three times	In power off mode, long press () till light flashes, then press ►II on remote controller, till heard buzzer 3 times, it means the coding is successful.
9	Suspend	Light-off	The device will enter the suspend state after standby 5 mins.


4.2 Charging Methods

4.2.1 Manual Charging:



1. Charging with the Charging Station:


After connecting the power adapter to the charging station and join the power cord, you can place the cleaner on the charging station for charging (The green indicator for recharge button will flicker during the charging, and will light on after the cleaner is fully charged).



2.Charging via the Remote Control:

Join the cleaner with the remote control according to the code first, and then press the \Uparrow button. The cleaner will automatically search for the charging station.


4.2.2 Auto Charging:



Automatic Charging:

The green indicator for recharge button will flicker and the device will enter the recharge mode if the power is low during the operation of the device.

Tips:


1. Customers should operate the cleaner within 7 meters distance covered by WIFI signal with our remote control; otherwise, the operation fails.

2.When press the "auto-recharge" button, the vacuum cleaner will may fail to return to the charging base either because of complex surrounding obstacles or running-out-of batteries.

Guidelines of Remote Control Use:


Function Guidelines	Function Information	
Start/Stop	 When the cleaner is in standby mode, press the button to enter the auto-cleaning mode. When the cleaner is at any cleaning mode, press the button to shift it to standby mode. When setting the time, press this button to hold settings. 	
Forward 🔺	Long-press the button and the cleaner will forward; releasing, it stops moving.	
Left-turn	Long-press the button and the cleaner rotates counterclockwise; releasing, it stops.	
Right-turn ▶	Long-press the button and the cleaner rotates clockwise; releasing, it stops rotating.	
Back V	Long-press the button and the cleaner moves backward less than 20cm before stop to prevent it from falling off stairs or anywhere;releasing,it stops moving	
Suction Regulation	 Press this button once and the buzzer will give a sound. The suction at the lower gear will be 600 Pa. Press this button again and the buzzer will give two sounds. The 800Pa and 1100Pa will switch automatically. Press it once again and the buzzer will give three sounds. The suction at the high gear will be 1300Pa. 	
Edge Cleaning	 Press this button and the cleaner will enter the edge cleaning mode. The cleaner will automatically enter the recharge mode after the edge cleaning. 	
Single Room ਿ Cleaning	 Press this button and the cleaner will enter the sing-room cleaning mode. The cleaner will automatically clean 30 mins at this mode. It will automatically enter the recharge mode after cleaning. 	
Time setting	 1.In the ON state, press this button and ⊕ and ⊕: on the screen will flicker. Set the hour by pressing "Up" or "Down" button. 2.Press the ◀ button/ ▶ button and switch to : ⊕ for minute setting. 3.After setting, press the Start/Stop button or Time Setting button to save it.




If do not use the cleaner for a long time please fully charge the battery first and store it in a dry place. Keep the bottom of the cleaner dry.


5.2 Cleaning of Charging Pole Pieces



1.Please turn off the power switch or disconnect the power plug first.


2.Please clean the charging pole pieces monthly with dry cloth.

3.Do not use oil for scrubbing.




As shown in the above figure, press the $\overline{\underline{w}}$ button on the box and the box will pop out. Then, take out the dustbin.


5.3.2 Clean the dust box




1.Open the baffle first, and then pour out the dust. Tips: The dustbin should be cleaned periodically.




2.Please clean the dustbin with the cleaning brush.



3. After take out the filter, wipe off the dust with the cleaning brush.




4.The dust box can be washed with running water. (Note: the dust box should be completely air-dried before re-inserting)




5. After cleaning, re-assemble the filter in the dustbin first, and then, insert the dustbin into the cleaner.

5.4 Clean the Main Brush


5.4.1 Disassemble the Main Brush



1. Push the locking-bar buckle and lift it upward.




2. Clutch the main brush and lift it upward.




3.Take out the middle brushes and its scraper assembly.

5.4.2 Cleaning the main brush and the rubber brush




1. Please clean the main brush and plastic brush with the cleaning brush regularly.




2. Please remove the hair and other entanglements on the main brush regularly.

5.5 Clean the Side Brush



1. Unscrew the screws on the side brush with a screwdriver.

5.6 Clean the Wheels




2. Take out the side brush, tidy the hair and trash on and inside the side brush base.



Clean the front, left and right wheels regularly with a cleaning brush.

5.7 Clean the Sensors



After each cleaning work is completed, dry cotton cloth is used to dry the transparent plate to prevent dust from being accumulated on the plate so as to affect the performance of this product.

6. Common Faults

Flash red light 2 times with one sound	Failure of left wheel	The left wheel doesn 't rotate and is overloaded.	Please check if there are twisters on the left wheel of the device.
Flash red light 3 times with one sound	Failure of right wheel	The right wheel doesn 't rotate and is overloaded.	Please check if there are twisters on the right wheel of the device.
Flash red light 5 times with one sound	Failure of front wheel or stucked	The front wheel gets stuck and doesn 't rotate.	Please check if there are twisters on the small wheels of the front wheel.
Flash red light 6 times with one sound	Failure of ground inspection or devide taking off	The cliff inductor is dirty.or cleaner will stop if off-ground 1s	Please check if the induction window on the bottom of the device is covered abnormally.or put cleaner on ground again.
Flash red light 7 times with one sound	Low electricity of battery	The battery power has been extremely low (non-recharge critical voltage).	Please let the device return to the charging station for charging put cleaner on ground again.
Flash red light 8 times with one sound	Failure of front collision	The switch can 't be reset due to collision of top cover.	Please check if the collision buffering is normal and whether it is loose.
Flash red light 9 times with one sound	Failure of middle main brush	The middle brush gets stuck	Please check if there are twisters on the middle main brush
Flash red light 10 times with one sound	Failure of side brushes	The side brushes get stuck	Please check if there are twisters on side brushes
Flash red light 12 times with one sound	Failure of fan	The fan doesn 't rotate but with large current.	Please check if the blades of the fan are loose or wrapped by hair and cloth.
Flash red light 13 times with one sound	Failure of dust box	The dust box isn ' t installed in the cleaner.	Please install the dust box in the cleaner and start cleaning again.
Flash red light 14 times with one sound	Failure of charging	The device can ' t be powered or show the charging state.	Please check the battery connection or change a new battery.
