PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your tablet comes equipped with an easy-to-use touchscreen. Our capacitive multi-touchscreen requires gentle fingertip touch on the screen to activate tablet's functions.

Multiple fingers may be used to perform gestures (e.g. 2-finger picture zoom).

Please note: Your fingertips must not be covered. A stylus may be used. Make sure it is designed for capacitive touchscreens.

Tips: To avoid damaging the screen, do not touch it with excessive force or with any object other than your finger. For best response, make sure your hands are clean before using the touch screen controls.

PROTECTIVE FILM

A thin film has been applied to the touchscreen to protect it during shipping. The protective film should be removed before use. To remove it, simply take a corner of the film and peel it away from the screen.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your NeuTab tablet comes with a built-in rechargeable lithium polymer battery. Before 1st time using the tablet, the battery should be charged fully to extend future battery life.

To charge the battery:

1. Plug one end of the included power adapter into an AC 100-240V outlet.
2. Plug the other end of the included power adapter into the Power jack on the tablet.
3. Disconnect the power adapter when the tablet is fully charged.

Warning: The battery used in this device may present a fire or chemical burn if misused. Do not disassemble, incinerate, or heat the device. Do not leave the device in a place subject to direct sunlight, or in a car with its windows closed. Do not connect the device to a power source other than that which is indicated here or on the label as this may result in the risk of fire or electric shock.

Resetting/Restarting the Tablet

Reset the tablet if it should freeze and not respond or otherwise malfunction.

1. Disconnect your tablet if it is connected to a computer.
2. Press and hold the POWER key for about 10 seconds to turn off the tablet, and then press and hold the POWER key until you see NeuTab logo.

GETTING STARTED

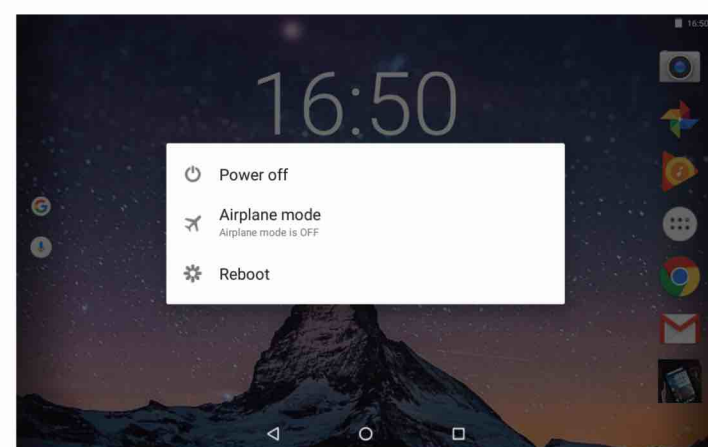
TURNING THE TABLET ON AND OFF

To turn the tablet on:

1. Press and hold the Power key until the LCD screen turns on and you see NeuTab Logo, then wait until you see the Unlock screen.

To turn the tablet off:

1. Press and hold the Power key until the "turn tablet off" message appears.
2. Touch OK to turn off the tablet.

TURNING THE SCREEN ON AND OFF (CONTD)

When the tablet is on, you can turn off the screen to conserve battery power. Simply press the Power button once to turn the screen off. Press the Power button again to turn the screen back on.

Tips: To conserve battery power, the screen can be set to turn off automatically when the tablet is not in use (between 15 seconds and 30 minutes). This Sleep option can be found in the Display menu.

UNLOCKING THE SCREEN

When the screen turns off, you will have to unlock the screen when you turn it back on.

To unlock the screen, touch and drag the lock icon to the edge of the circle that appears (or swipe up to unlock).

If a password has been set, enter the password to finish unlocking the screen. The Screen Unlock password can be set in the Security settings menu.

Warning: Please write down your password lock pattern/PIN/password. Misplacing or forgetting this method will lock the user out. Updating device firmware will reset the device to factory default and remove password, but all your data & programs will be lost. NeuTab takes no responsibility of retrieving information and data on locked devices.

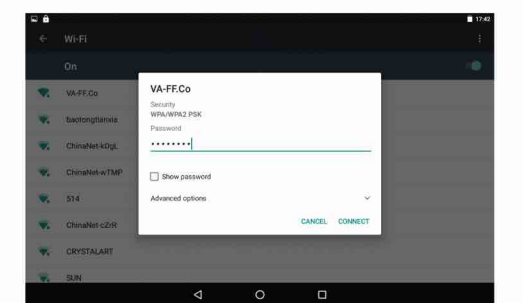
YOUR TABLET HOME SCREEN

The home screen is the starting point for all of the features of your tablet.

- 1 **Google Search**
Touch to search with Google Search Engine.
- 2 **VOICE Search**
Search by voice input.
- 3 **Home icon**
Touch to back to the central Home Screen.
- 4 **Back icon**
Touch to go back to the previous screen.
- 5 **Recent Apps**
Touch to display the list of thumbnails of apps you have worked recently. Touch a thumbnail to open it.
- 6 **Applications Tab**
Open the Application Launcher to view the list of all Applications and Widgets installed on the tablet. Touch the applications tab to open the Launcher.
- 7 **Icons**
Touch an icon to open an application or application folder.
- 8 **Notification bar**
Shows notification icons and time, battery level, plus the network signal strength; touch the bar to open the full Notifications panel. Touch a Notification icon to display more detail.

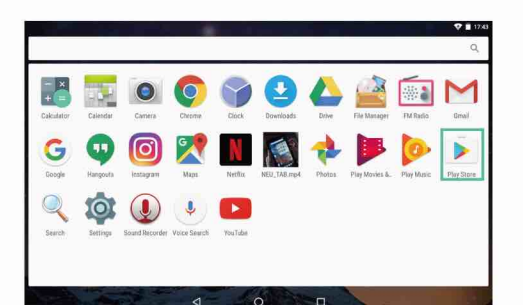


DOWNLOAD APPLICATIONS

This tablet is Google certified and has Google Play Store pre-installed. When connected to WiFi network, you can browse apps in Play Store and download/install them.

THE PLAY STORE

Google Play Store can be found in the applications menu, you can always tap-hold-drag it to the main screen to make it easier to access.

CONNECTING TO THE INTERNET

This tablet can utilize Wi-Fi data networks to connect to the Internet. Wireless Wi-Fi technology can provide Internet access at distances of over 300 feet; however, this distance can be affected by your surrounding environment and Wi-Fi router. In general, being closer to Wi-Fi router improve performance.

REQUIREMENTS

In order to connect to the Internet, you will need either of the following:

A wireless router or access point with a broadband Internet connection. The tablet can receive 802.11 b/g/n Wi-Fi radio. The tablet will also work with wireless routers that only support 802.11 b/g.

You will need to know the name of your network (SSID), as well as the password or other credentials if your network is secured. These settings can usually be found on the administration webpage of your wireless router.

Tips: You may encounter open Wi-Fi networks, or "hotspots". These networks are usually configured so that you can simply connect to them without needing to know its settings; the tablet will obtain all the information it needs from the router automatically.

Warning: Open Wi-Fi networks operates under the risk of information surveillance, your account information, especially password and other credentials might be audited by third parties. Please use caution when connected to open hotspots.

CONNECT TO A WI-FI NETWORK

The Notification bar displays icons that indicate your tablet's Wi-Fi status.

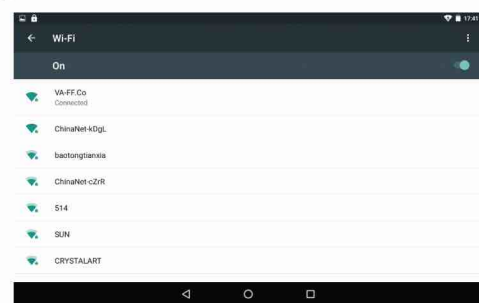

1. Turn on the Wi-Fi radio if it is not already on. To turn on Wi-Fi:

- Go to the Home screen: Touch the Home icon.
- Open the Launcher screen: Touch the Launcher Tab, then touch Settings.
- Open the Wireless & networks menu: Touch WIRELESS & NETWORKS.
- Open the Wi-Fi settings menu: Touch Wi-Fi.
- Make sure that the Wi-Fi option box is settled to ON: Touch and slide the block right to enable the Wi-Fi connection.

When Wi-Fi is on, the tablet will look for and display a list of available Wi-Fi networks.



2. Select an available Wi-Fi network to connect to:

In the same Wi-Fi settings menu above, touch a network in the list.

If the network is open, the tablet will prompt you to confirm connection to the network. Touch Connect to confirm.

If the network is secured (as indicated by a Lock icon), the tablet will prompt you to enter a password or other credentials. Touch the Wireless password box to show the on-screen keyboard and then use it to enter the password. Touch Connect to confirm.

When you have successfully connected to a Wi-Fi network, the Notifications bar at the bottom of the screen will show a Wi-Fi signal indicator.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS
