

Bluetooth self-shooter usage statement

1. Open the back battery cover of the Bluetooth selfie camera, install the battery CR2032, and you can work. Press the power on key, and the blue light LED will flash normally when used. When not in use, when disconnected, the product will automatically enter hibernation mode, which is easy to use, energy-saving and environmental protection.

Two. Turn on the Bluetooth of your mobile phone and search for the Bluetooth device. After finding the Bluetooth selfie device, click Connect Pairing. If the connection is successful, you can use it.

3. When you need to pair with another mobile phone, just press and hold the photo button for about 3 seconds. First, let it follow a mobile phone to untie it. Then search for Bluetooth device connection and pairing, turn on the camera, and you can use it and take photos freely.

Four. IOS system and Android system do not need to switch keys. As long as you connect and pair the corresponding mobile phone, you can use the Bluetooth selfie camera to take photos.
