Before you begin, check your package contents to make sure you have all of the following:

- ***** Remote Control (RC)

- ***** Set-Top Box (STB)

- ***** STB Power Adapter & HDMI Cable

FIRST:

Setup the ***** STB using the instructions provided in the STB Customer Setup Guide

NEXT:

Follow the steps below to set up your ***** Remote Control (RC) STEP 1: Check that your ***** STB is connected to your TV and is plugged in to a power outlet. Make sure your TV is ON

STEP 2: Pull and Remove the plastic tab on the back of the ***** RC to activate the batteries.

4 AAA batteries come already installed in the Remote Control.

STEP 3:

• Follow the on-screen instructions to set up the ***** RC for your TV's Mfg. and Model. Your ****® **** Remote Control comes already paired with and ready to control the ****® **** STB that it was shipped with.



Troubleshooting:

PROBLEM:

You point the ***** Remote Control at the TV, press the "Power Button", and nothing happens.

SOLUTION:

1. Check that the TV is connected to the ***** STB and that the TV has the correct input selected.

You may need to use the TV's remote control to change the TVs Input to the correct source.

- 2. Check that the ***** STB is plugged into a power adaptor and that the power indicator light is on.
- 3. Check that you have completely removed the plastic tab on the back of the ***** Remote Control.
- 4. Check that when you press a button on the ***** Remote Control, the indicator light on the bottom front of the Remote control lights up.

You may need to replace the AAA batteries in the Remote Control.

5. Check that the ***** Remote Control is in the same room as the ***** STB that it came packaged with.

You may need to move the ***** Remote Control back into the room with the ***** STB that is was packaged with.
