Contents of the package:

How to perform the initial setup of your device:

1. Remove plastic covering and sleeve.
2. Plug the included AC adapter DC plug into the charging dock.
3. Plug the AC adaptor AC plug into a rated power outlet.
4. Place device securely on top of the dock. The screen will light up if the dock is connected correctly.
5. Follow device instructions.

Using Your Device Around Other Electronic Devices

Information Regarding Exposure to Radio Frequency Energy

The Device meets the government's requirements for exposure to radio waves. The Device is designed and manufactured not to exceed the emission limits for exposure to radio frequency (RF) energy set by the Federal Communications Commission of the U.S. Government.

The exposure standard employs a unit of measurement known as the Specific Absorption Rate, or SAR. The SAR limit set by the FCC is 1.6 W/kg. Tests for SAR are conducted using standard operating positions accepted by the FCC with the EUT (equipment under test) transmitting at the specified power level in different channels.
