Remotely unlocked through App on smartphone.

Unlock via Button Code



Click on the lock button with your custom set pattern to unlock it, even your smartphone is not near.

Note: The code should contain 4 digits. Valid digits: 1,2,3,4

Separation Alarm



If you accidentally forget your suitcase secured with our lock, the App will make sound to notify you and never worry about leaving things behind.

Last Known Location



View the last known location of your smartlock-secured item in the App.
