SUBJECT: Rationalization for Request for Confidentiality, FCC ID: 2AGZM-A01116

WISER Systems, Inc. has invested considerable capital, time, and materials in the R&D required to invent and produce the referenced real time localization system and its components. The permanently confidential portions of this application, if they were made public and accessible by competitors, would provide them with significant competitive advantages in developing similar products very quickly because they would not have to spend the exhaustive R&D and testing time and false starts that we incurred in developing our system.

Furthermore, WISER Systems is in-process of design patenting our devices and sensors; photographs of our devices made public on the FCC website would inhibit our ability to patent prior to public disclosure.

Finally, disclosure of the successful implementation of WISER's unpublished, cutting-edge technology would also provide our competitors with significant competitive advantages.

Disclosure of any of the confidential portions of this application during the period of importation and/or distribution would reveal key aspects of proprietary technology to competitors and counterfeit operators who do not respect US laws, and diminish WISER competitiveness internationally and the value of our investment in research and development, and its potential return.

Therefore, pursuant to Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's Rules, we hereby request permanent and temporary confidential treatment of information accompanying this application as outlined in the enclosed Confidentiality Request.
