TROUBLE SHOOTING

Check this list for a possible trouble shooting solution.

Cannot power on

Check the battery power if it is too low. Connect the adaptor and power on again.

After powering on, the screen starts blinking and power off suddenly

Battery power is low, please charge in time.

No sound output

Check the volume setting, and adjust the volume level by tapping Volume+/- buttons.

Check if the audio file is damaged; try to choose another audio to play.

Cannot copy files or play audio files Check if the connection is available.

Check if the unit has enough storage memory.

System has errors

Power off the unit and then power on again by holding and pressing the (Power) button.

Restore the system to factory default.

BASIC OPERATION

Tap: Tap an item or App once to select the item or launch the App.


Long-tap: Tap and hold the current operating interface or area until the relevant items appear, then release.

Pinch & Spread: Use two fingers to tap the screen, and adjust the distance between them to zoom in/out the current photo or web contents.

WI-FI CONNECTION


Before creating the WI-FI connection, please ensure that your

Tips & shortcuts

*Type capital letters: Touch the shift key \bigcirc once to switch to capital letters for one letter. Or touch & hold the shift key \bigcirc while you type. When you release the key, the lowercase letters reappear

*Turn caps lock on: Double-tap or touch & hold the shift key $\, \widehat{\,\,\,\,}$, so it changes to $\, \widehat{\,\,\,\,}$, Touch the shift key $\, \widehat{\,\,\,\,}$ again to return to lowercase.

*Show numbers or symbols: Touch the ?123 key. To see more choices, touch the ~\{ key.

*Type special characters: Touch & hold the shift key $\, \widehat{\,\,\,\,\,\,} \,$ while you touch a key with a small gray character in its corner to enter the gray character.

*Touch & hold any key to see alternative letters, symbols, or numbers, which you can then touch to type.

*Change input language or keyboard: Touch the key, then Input options menu appears. Choose the option you want to adjust.

Use folders

You can combine several appicons in a folder. Drop one appicon over another on a Home screen, and the two icons will be combined.

Organize your apps with folders

To make a new folder on your Home screen, stack one app on top of another.

From any Home screen, you can

- * Open a folder: Touch it. The folder opens.
- * Rename a folder: Touch its name.
- * Move icons around your Home screen: Touch, hold, and slide.
- * As with any folder, you can customize its contents.
- *After you open an app, you can usually adjust its settings by choosing items from its menu icon near the top of the screen

From here, you can:

- 1.Read email. Touch a message to read it. Unread messages are bold.
- 2.Organize email. Check the box beside a message to select it. Then use the icons and menu at the top of the screen to manage the selected messages.
- 3. Change your settings. Touch the menu icon to change your preferences, add star, report spam, etc.

CAMERA.

Tap the on the main screen or in the Apps menu to take photos or record using the camera. The photos and videos will be stored into the File Manage automatically.



CONNECTING TO PC

CONNECTING TO EARPHONE

You can connect an earphone to the earphone jack for personal listening.


