


Pairing Indicator Light

Power/Pair/Play/Pause/

Press and hold for approx. 7 seconds to power the unit on and begin pairing. Press to play or pause the current track. Press and hold to power off.

Push up or down to adjust volume.






Charging the Battery

Requires a Micro-USB to USB cable (included).

 Using a Micro-USB to USB cable (included), connect to the USB port of a powered on computer or USB power adaptor (not included) to charge the unit.

Bluetooth Wireless Audio

Pairing to a Device and Playing Audio

- Press and hold the Power/Pair button on the unit for approximately
 7 seconds to power the unit on and begin pairing. The pairing indicator
 will flash red and blue. When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the unit.
- Using the controls on your Bluetooth device, select GuruGear in your Bluetooth settings/device menu. If your device requests a password, enter the default password 0000. Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.
- When successfully paired, an audible chime will sound from the speakers and the pairing indicator will slowly flash blue. Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the headphones.
- 4. Use the controls on the connected device to select and begin playing audio. Use the controls on the connected Bluetooth device or the controls on the headphones to play, pause and adjust the volume.

After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user, or erased due to a reset of the device. If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the steps listed above.

Using the Speakerphone

- 1. When a call is received, a ringtone will sound through the speakers.
- 2. Press the **Power/Pair/Play/Pause** button to accept the call or accept the call with the native controls on the connected device.
- 3. The incoming call received through the device will now be heard through the headphones.
- 4. To end the call, press the **Power/Pair/Play/Pause** button or end the call using the native controls on the connected device.

Line In

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (included).

Note: The headphones do not have to be powered on to hear music through the Line Input. This feature can be used to conserve battery power.

- Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the Line In port on the unit and the audio output or headphone jack on an audio device.
- 2. Use the controls on the connected device to play your audio through the unit.
