Charging Your Headset:

1. Plug the Micro-USB charging cable into your headset.
2. Plug the other end of the Micro-USB cable into a USB port on a computer or power adapter.
3. Charge for 1-3 hours or until the red charging indicator light shuts off.
4. Unplug your headset, it is now ready for use.

CONTROLS:

- Next Song/Volume Up
- Multifunction Button (MFB): ON/OFF, Answer, End, Reject Call, Play, Pause
- Previous Song/Volume Down

Pairing the Headset With a Compatible Phone:

1. Make sure your headset is turned off.
2. Push the **MFB** key for about 5-7 seconds until the light flashes blue and red alternately.
3. Activate the Bluetooth® feature on the device, and set the device to search for the Bluetooth® devices. The name of the Wireless Headset is **HM -BE-216**. See the user guide of your device for instructions.

4. If the pairing is successful, the headset's blue light will flash every 6 seconds.

5. If pass code is requested enter (0000). Once the headset has paired with your device, no password will be needed to reconnect.

Power ON/OFF & Reconnecting:

- To switch ON: Press and Hold the **MFB** key until the Blue Indicator light blinks on and off.
- To switch OFF: Press and Hold the **MFB** key until the Red Indicator light blinks on and off.
- Adjust Volume: Press and Hold the **+** to Increase and the **-** to Decrease volume.
- Next Song: Press the **+** button.
- Previous song: Press the **-** button.

- Pause Song: Press the **MFB** button while music is playing.

- Answer/End a Call: Press the **MFB** button, or use the phone keys (music will automatically pause during phone calls).

- Reject a Call: Press and Hold **MFB** key, or use the phone keys.

- Redial the Last Dialed Out Number: Press the **MFB** button twice quickly.

Warning
