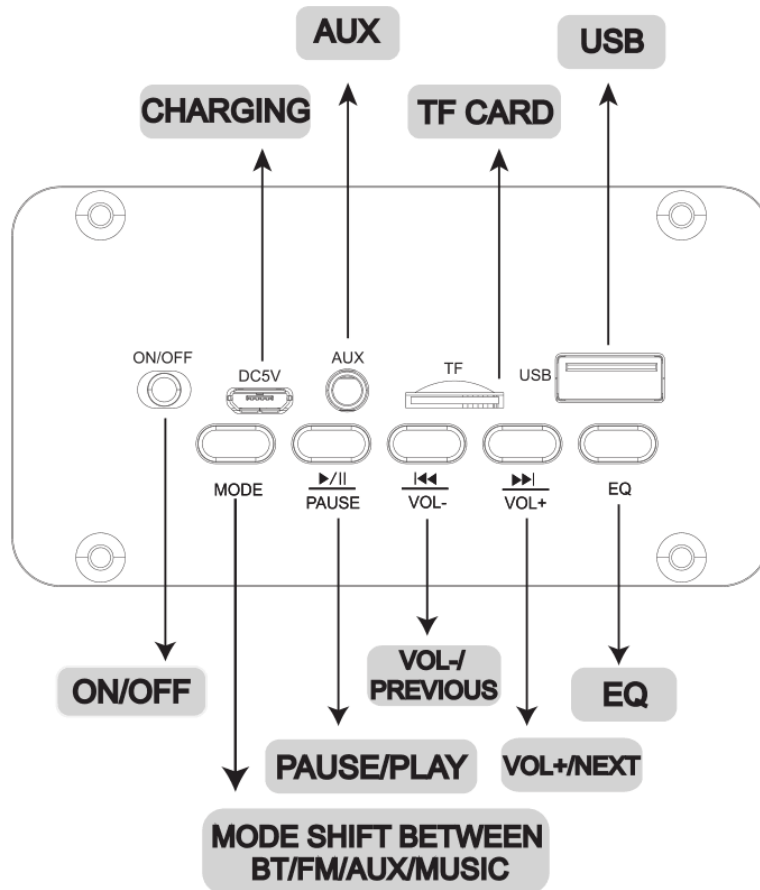

* Features

* Control Panel Instructions



1. **ON/OFF** : Power switch for turn on /off the unit
2. : **MODE** :Mode shift between BT/FM/AUX/MUSIC
3. Press the ▶|| for **PAUSE/PLAY**
 Press & Hold ▶|| for auto search the FM frequency and save the FM station in FM mode.
4. Press **VOL+/NEXT** ▶▶ to jump to the next song / FM Tuning,
 Press & Hold **VOL+/NEXT** ▶▶ to increase the volume.
5. Short press **VOL-/PREVIOUS** ◀◀ to go back to the previous song / FM Tuning,
 Press & Hold **VOL-/PREVIOUS** ◀◀ to decrease the volume.

(Remarks: also can turn the volume knob to adjust the volume)

6. **CHARGING** : plug in the USB cable for charging(adaptor not included)
7. **AUX** : 3.5mm aux-in jack
8. **EQ** : Equalizer for selection
9. **TF CARD** : Micro SD card slot
10. **USB** : Use 2.0 version Flash card in FAT 32 format

***Connect to BT device**

1)Turn on the unit, it will enter into BT mode. Turn on the BT function on your mobile or other device and search for the model name "PS-02B". Then Pair the device.

2)Once device is paired, BT will automatically connect

Remarks: can not support hands-free calling
