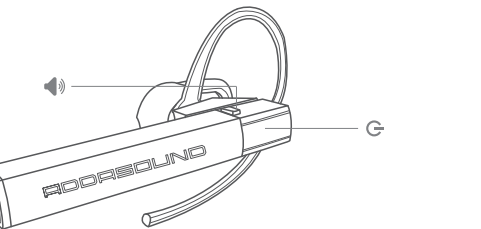

QUICK START GUIDE

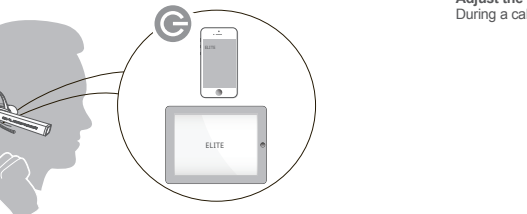


- Volume adjustment button
- Power / Pairing, pressing 5 seconds to enter pairing model

Pair Mobile Phone or Pad

- Put the headset on and push the power button for 3 seconds until you hear the voice prompt "power on".
- Long-press the call button until you hear the voice prompt "pairing" as confirmation. The headset enters the pairing mode.
- Then switch on the "Bluetooth" function on your mobile phone or pad and search for Bluetooth headset devices
- Select "ADDASOUND ELITE"
- Once the devices have been paired successfully, there will be the voice prompt "Connected"

Note: If you turn off or exit the "Bluetooth" mode of your mobile phone or pad, the headset will be in "Standby" mode, there will be the voice prompt "Disconnected".



Can pair two devices

- If you have paired your headset to a mobile phone or a Pad, directly activate the "Bluetooth" function of a second device and search for headset devices.
- Press the call button for 2 seconds to turn the headset off
- Long-press the call button for 5 seconds until you hear "pairing"
- Select "ADDASOUND ELITE".
- After both devices are connected, you can choose alternative use of any one device to receive a call or listen to music.

Call Control

Answer a call
To answer the call please short-press the call button .

End a call
While a call in progress Short-press the call button to end the current call.

Reject a call
Press the call button for 3 seconds to reject the incoming call.

Redial the last calling number
To redial the last calling number, double-click the call button . You will hear "Last number redial" as confirmation. The last calling number will then be automatically called.

Adjust the volume
During a call, turn up/down the volume adjustment button by pressing .

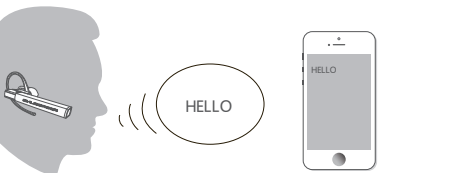
Audio Play Control

Your headset supports playing audio files on A2DP activated mobile devices.

Connect Phone by using voice input method

- Please visit <http://addasound.com> please download bluesound (phone version) & install.
- While headset is in connection mode, please start the Bluesound software.

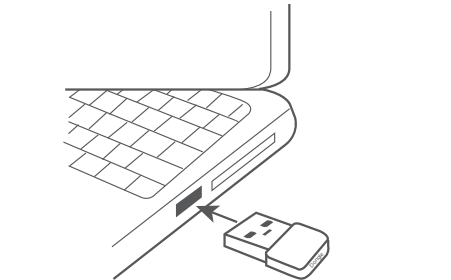
*For the voice input function on Mobile voice-recognition software, required users to use the 3rd party voice recognition assistant softwares.



Connect PC by using Voice input method

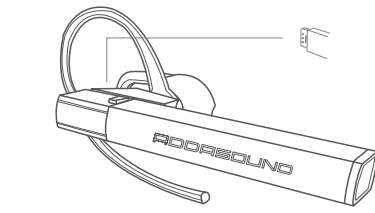
- Please visit <http://addasound.com> please download bluesound (PC version) & install.
- Plug the Bluetooth adapter into the computer USB port and run the BlueSound software.
- Put the headset on, enter pairing mode and the "Bluesound software" will search and pair the connection.
- Please Open computer's "Control Panel," and add ADDASOUND ELITE as the default audio device.

*For the voice input function on PC voice-recognition software, required users to use the 3rd party voice recognition assistant softwares.
*Can be used as VOIP for internet phone devices, such as Skype, Lync and others.



Charge

We recommend use USB cable to charge your headset.

WARNING!

Permanent hearing loss may result from long-term exposure to sound at high volumes. Use as low a volume as possible and avoid prolonged used of the headset at excessive sound pressure levels. Please read the Safety Guidelines below prior to using the headset.

You Can Reduce the Risk of Hearing Damage by Following These Safety Guidelines During the Use of the Product:

- Turn the volume control to its lowest level, when connecting the headset and then slowly adjust the volume control to a comfortable level.
- Keep the volume at the lowest level possible.
- If increased volume is necessary, adjust the volume control slowly.
- If you experience discomfort or ringing in your ears, immediately discontinue using the headset.

Note: With continued use at a high volume, your ears may become accustomed to the sound level, which may result in permanent damage to your hearing without any noticeable discomfort.

SAFETY INFORMATION !

- If you are a pacemaker or other electrical medical devices, you should consult your physician before using the product.
- This package contains small parts that may be hazardous to children. Always store the product out of reach of children. The bags themselves or the many small parts they contain may cause choking if ingested.
- Never try to dismantle the product yourself, or push objects of any kind into the product, as this may cause short circuits which could result in a fire or electric shock.
- None of the components can be replaced or repaired by users. Only authorized dealers or service centers may open the product. If any parts of your product require replacement for any reason, including normal wear and tear or breakage, contact your dealer.
- Avoid exposing your product to rain, moisture or other liquids.
- If the product overheats, has been dropped or damaged or has been dropped in a liquid, discontinue use.
- Never mount or store the product over any airbag deployment area, as serious injury may result when an airbag deploys.

BUILT-IN BATTERY CARE:

- Your product is powered by a rechargeable battery. The full performance of a new battery is achieved only after two or three complete charge and discharge cycles. Do not leave a fully charged battery connected to a charger, since overcharging may shorten its lifetime.
- If left unused, a fully charged battery will lose its charge over time.
- Leaving the product in hot or cold places, such as in a closed car in the summer and winter conditions, will reduce the capacity and lifetime of the battery.
- Always try to keep the battery between 0°C and 45°C. A product with a hot or cold battery may not work temporarily, even when the battery is fully charged.

BATTERY WARNING!

- "Caution"-The battery used in the product may present a risk of fire or chemical burn if mistreated. Batteries may explode if damaged.
- Only recharge your battery with the provided approved chargers designated for the product.
- Dispose of batteries according to local regulations. Please recycle when possible. Do not dispose the battery as household waste or in a fire as it may explode.
- Unless otherwise specified in the user manual or quick start guide the battery in your product can not be removed or replaced by the user. Any attempt to do so is risky and may result in damage of the product.

HOW TO CHARGE YOUR ELITE:

- Simply charge your Elite with ADDASOUND data cable where you can find in accessories
- Recharge the battery only with the data cable designated for the product. Use of another data cable or charger may damage or destroy the product and will invalidate the warranty.
- Charging time: 1.5h

CERTIFICATION AND SAFETY APPROVALS:

- This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:
1. This device may not cause harmful interference.
