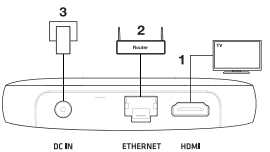

## Install ODK Box

- 1 Connect the ODK box to the TV with an HDMI cable. See figure for connectors.
- 2 If the router is close to the box, connect it directly using the Ethernet cable you have at home. - If the Ethernet cable is difficult to connect to, please connect to Wi-Fi /Wireless Internet. (See Step 4.)
- 3 Connec power adapter.

## Change the TV input Source

- 1 Use the TV manufacturer's remote control to change to the corresponding HDMI with the box connected.
- 2 Press the Input or Source button on the TV manufacturer's remote control for adjustment. <SAMSUNG, LG, VIZIO, etc.>
