To assure continued high performance from our Recorder periodically. Cleaning the heads, pinch rollers and capstans whenever an accumulation of dust and tape oxide deposits. These particles may be cleaned with a cotton swab moistened with alcohol (methylated spirit) or special head-cleaning fluid

- Depress the STOP/EJECT BUTTON and remove the cassette.
- Carefully rub the face of the heads and also the surface of the capstans and the pinch rollers.






