Charge the headset

Your headset uses a rechargeable battery, you must charge the battery fully before using the headset for the first time.

1. Plugging the charging cable in the USB charge port.
2. The red indicator remains light when charging.
3. The fully charging takes 1-2 hours.
4. The red indicator goes out when charging completed. (when headset get into the low power protection status, it will take extra 1 hours to back into/normal charging procedure)

Power on/off headset

- A. To power on: press and hold multifunction button until the led light flash in blue and red light
- B. To power off: when headset is power on , press and hold multifunction button until the led indicator light flash in red light and goes off.

FM Function Mode:

After the headset is power on, If you want to use FM function.

Quickly press multifunction button twice, The headset will enter the FM mode and search station automatically. After finishing the search., It will save Fm station automatically.

Short Pressing + or - key to find the station you like.

Long pressing + or - key to change volume

If you want to go back to Bluetooth function mode, Just Quickly press multifunction button twice.

Bluetooth Function Mode:

1. Press and hold multifunction button until the led light flash in blue and red light.

The red and blue light flashing, it is waiting for connect Bluetooth devices.

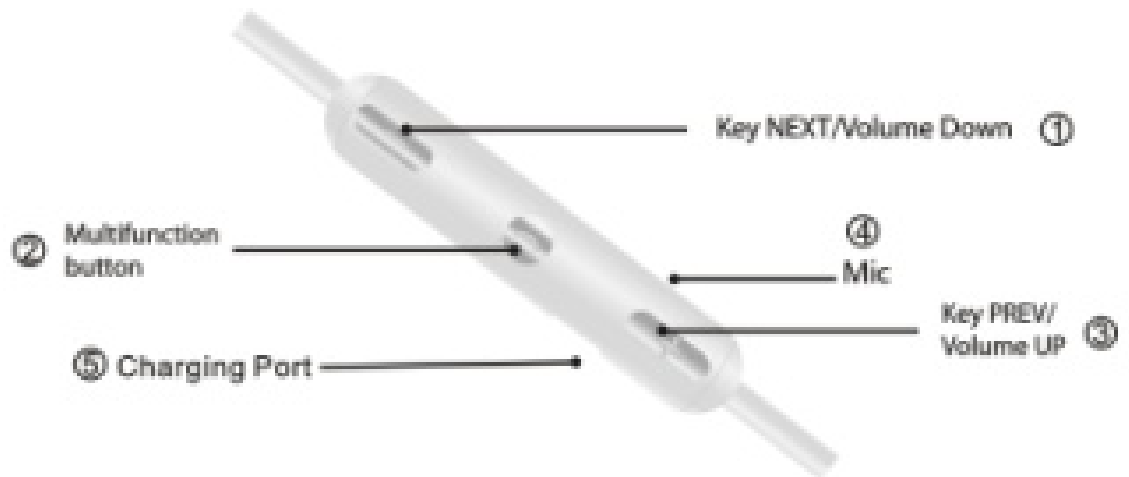
Search and find QFX-BT-420 in your mobile or other device to connect it.
The indicator light will show blue in every 5 seconds (some mobile phone need to input password (0000))

2. In the Bluetooth mode, For coming call, short pressing multifunction button.

For listening music, Short pressing multifunction button for pause

Press and hold + or – key for increase or decrease volume until you feel the music volume is suitable for u, then release.

For change song to Previous or Next, Short pressing + or – key to change.



1. Key NEXT/VOLUME DOWN
2. Multi-functional key
3. Key PREV/VOLUME UP
4. Mic
5. Charging port

Answering call

- A. Press the answer key on your phone.
- B. Press the multifunction button on your headset.

Ending call

- A. Press the end key on your phone.
- B. Press the multifunction button on your headset.

Rejection a call

- A. Press the end key on your phone.
- B. Press and hold the multifunction button on your handset for about 3 seconds when call is coming

Redialing the last number

Double click the multifunction button when headset is in standby mode.

Playing Music

You can listen to the music from PC or mobile phone.
