
## **BATTERY INSTALLATION**

Before playing, an ADULT must install fresh alkaline batteries in the CAR and REMOTE. Here's how:

1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw and battery compartment cover
from the underside of the RC vehicle. (Fig. 1)

2. Install three (3) fresh 1.5V AA alkaline batteries (not included) in the RC vehicle making sure the (+)

# REMOTE CONTROL

1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw and battery compartment cover from the underside of the remote. (Fig. 2)

2. Install two (2) fresh 1.5V AAA alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends

face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment. (Fig. 2)

3. Replace the compartment cover back in original position and tighten the screw.
