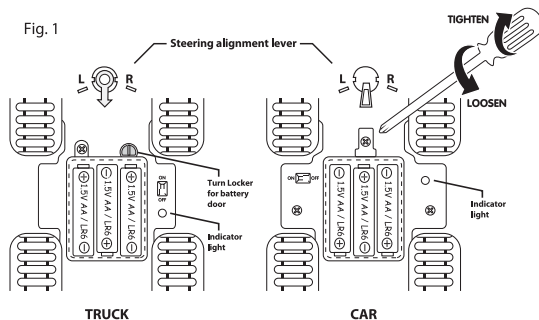
Tools Needed:
Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) required for battery replacement. Alkaline batteries recommended. Installation of batteries should only be done by an adult. Keep content details for future reference.

BACK

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Before playing, an ADULT must install fresh alkaline batteries in the CAR and REMOTE. Here's how:

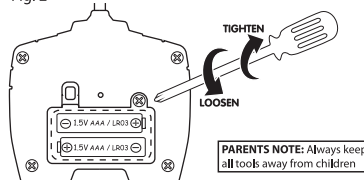
1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw and battery compartment cover from the underside of the RC vehicle. (Fig. 1)
2. Install three (3) fresh 1.5V AA alkaline batteries (not included) in the RC vehicle making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment. (Fig. 1)
3. Place the compartment cover back in original position and tighten the screw.



REMOTE CONTROL

1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw and battery compartment cover from the underside of the remote. (Fig. 2)
2. Install two (2) fresh 1.5V AAA alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment. (Fig. 2)
3. Replace the compartment cover back in original position and tighten the screw.

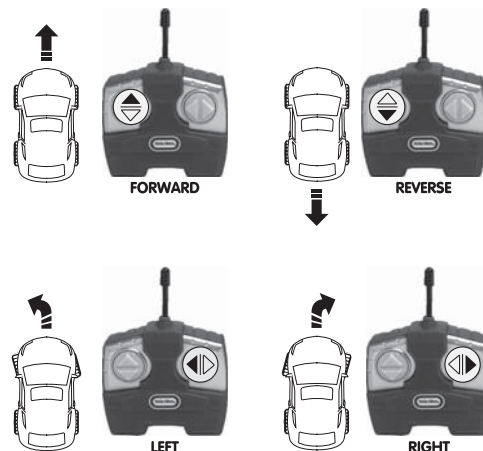
QUICK START

DRIVING THE RC VEHICLE

1. Place the RC vehicle on the floor.
2. To assure your RC vehicle will pick up the correct frequency, first slide to the "ON" position located under vehicle.

NOTE: When finished playing, turn OFF the RC vehicle.

In the event of a malfunction, reset the item by removing and replacing the batteries. If function is still not restored, replace the batteries with fresh alkaline batteries.
