


Test Method:

For emission measurements at or below 1 GHz, the sample was placed 0.8m above the ground plane of semi-anechoic Chamber*. For emission measurements above 1 GHz, the sample was placed 1.5m above the ground plane of semi-anechoic Chamber*. Measurements in both horizontal and vertical polarities were performed. During the test, each emission was maximized by: having the EUT continuously working, investigated all operating modes, rotated about all 3 axis (X, Y & Z) and considered typical configuration to obtain worst position, manipulating interconnecting cables, rotating turntable, varying antenna height from 1m to 4m in both horizontal and vertical polarizations. 

In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the frequency band in which the spread spectrum or digitally modulated intentional radiator is operating, the radio frequency power that is produced by the intentional radiator shall be at least 20 dB below that in the 100 kHz bandwidth within the band that contains the highest level of the desired power, based on either an RF conducted or a radiated measurement. Band-edge Compliance of RF Emissions - Lower band edge






 $Tx\ mode\ GFSK\ (Tx:\ 2402MHz\ to\ 2480MHz)$


CH 19 (2440.0 MHz)



6dB Bandwidth of Fundamental Emission on GFSK (2402MHz)









RF Exposure

Requirements:

In 15.247(i), an equipment shall be operated in a manner that ensures that the public is not exposed to radio frequency energy levels in excess of the limits in §§ 1.1310 and 2.1093 of this chapter.

Applications to the Commission for construction permits, licenses to transmit or renewals thereof, equipment authorizations or modifications in existing facilities must contain a statement confirming compliance with the limits unless the facility, operation, or transmitter is categorically excluded, as discussed below. Technical information showing the basis for this statement must be submitted to the Commission upon request.










Inner Circuit Bottom View




