

Flowerpot Bluetooth Speaker

User Manual

COMPONENTS INCLUDED:

- 1 x Flowerpot Bluetooth Speaker
- 1 x User Manual
- 1 x Charging Cable

DESCRIPTIONS OF EACH KEY:

- (1)Long press: Power On/Off
- Short press: Mode Selection
- (2) Short press: Move to previous music

Long press: Volume up

- (3) Short press: Move to next music
- Long press: Volume down
- 4 Pause/Turn on or turn off Light
- \bigcirc Charging Port

Flowerport Music Mode:

>>Turn on the speaker, the indicator lights will turn on and hear the alert sound. Speaker enters to music mode.

>>Touch the leaf, you will hear the music.

>>Under music mode, adjust the volume by long press ② and③ button. Select music by short

press 0 and 3 button.

Light Mode:

>>Press ① button to select the light mode. >>Touch the leaf, the LED light color will be changed. There is no voice under light mode.

BLUETOOTH SPEAKER OPERATION:

>>Turn on the speaker, Press (1) button to select Bluetooth mode. Blue indicator light will flash rapidly to detect nearby Bluetooth enabled devices.

>> Look for "music" appear on the list of Bluetooth devices from your device. Type Password "0000" or "1234" if requested.

>>Once unit is successfully paired and connected. Blue lights turn off.

>>Under bluetooth mode, adjust the volume by long press (2) and (3) button. Select music by short press (2) and (3) button.
