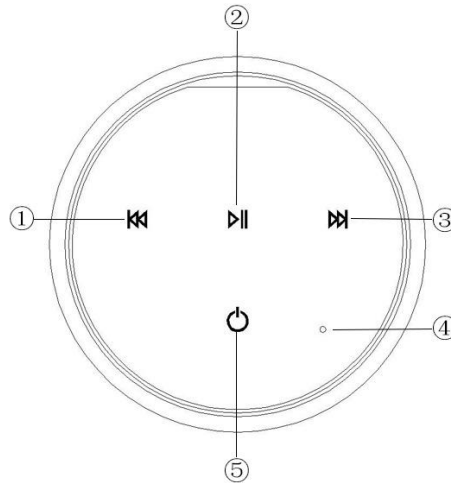


Bluetooth Speaker User Manual

Model : ISB2139

1. Illustration



- ① Previous/V-: Press to go to previous song, press and hold to decrease the volume.
- ② Play/Pause: Press to pause while playing music, press again to recover to play; press to search channels automatically under FM radio mode.
- ③ Next/V+: Press to go to next song, press and hold to increase the volume.
- ④ Microphone: For hands free talking.
- ⑤ Power on/off&Mode Shift: Press and hold for power on or off, press to shift mode for TF card/USB/AUX-IN



2. Bluetooth connection

Turn on the Bluetooth speaker (press and hold the key ⑤ until the indicator blue and red color flashing alternately; then enter your mobile phone to turn on the Bluetooth and search "D11", then press it to connect.

3. TF card/USB play

When you insert TF card or USB, the speaker will shift to play music from TF card or USB flash drive automatically.

4. AUX-IN

Please use the AV cable from the accessories along with Bluetooth speaker to insert into speaker and mobile phone, then you can get the sound via speaker.

5. FM radio

When you change into the mode FM radio via the key ⑤, press the key ② to search the channels automatically and you can change the channels volume via the key ① or ③.

6. Charging

The indicator will display red color while charging.
