
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
#	Item	Description
1	Mode button	(1) Press Mode button to power at Bluetooth mode as default (2) Press Mode button to switch between Bluetooth and FM mode (3) Press and hold Mode button x 3 seconds for OFF mode
2	Alarm button	In Clock mode, press to turn on or turn off alarm; In other modes, press to return to Clock mode; In any mode, press and hold 3 seconds to enter alarm clock settings.
3	Clock button	In other modes, press to return to Clock mode; In any modes, press and hold 3 seconds to enter clock settings.
4	Dimmer/Snooze/ Sleep	When alarm rings, you can press to adjust the interval to repeat alarm. The alarm repeats ringing 10 minutes later. When alarm not rings, press it to adjust LED brightness, press and hold 2 seconds to set up sleep timer.
5	Volume Down/ Previous Track	In BT mode, press to switch to previous track; In FM Mode, press to tune in 0.1MHz increments or switch preset stations, double-click to start auto scan until find a lower available channel, and press and hold to decrease volume. In any modes, press and hold to decrease volume.
6	Play/Pause	In AUX mode and BT mode, press to play or pause audio; in FM mode, press to enter preset station play mode, press and hold 2 seconds to set preset station.
7	Volume Up/ Next Track	In BT mode, press to switch to next track; In FM Mode, press to tune in 0.1MHz increments or switch preset stations, double-click to start auto scan until find an upper available channel. In any modes, press and hold to increase volume.

1	AUX IN jack	Connect to an external audio device.
2	FM antenna	The FM antenna is an 80cm pigtail cable, keep it fully extended to get the best signal reception.
3	USB port	Connect to charge an external device.
4	DC IN jack	Connect to the included power adapter.

1	Current time	Displays the current time.
2	AM/PM	"AM" lights after midnight and before noon, and "PM" lights after noon and before midnight.
3	Alarm	Lights when alarm has been set and enabled.
4	Bluetooth	Lights when BT mode is selected.
5	AUX	Lights when an external audio is connected.
6	FM	Lights when FM mode is selected.
7	MHz	Lights when FM mode is selected.

Connect to Power

- Risk of product damage! Use the include 9V/3A Power Adapter ONLY. Connect the AC power cord to the wall socket

Power off

In any modes, press and hold $\,M\,$ button for 3 seconds to turn off the machine. Only clock will be shown on display. (Without alarm and BT icon)

Set Clock Time

In any modes, press and hold (9) button for 3 seconds, you will see the LED hour section blinks, then press 4/- or +/ b button to adjust the hour, after hour is set, press \bigcirc button to switch to minute, the LED minute blinks, then press 4/- or +/ b button to adjust the minute, after minute is set, press \bigcirc lt to confirm setting (If no button is pressed for 15 seconds, the setting is saved

Set Alarm Time

In any modes, press and hold \triangle button for 3 seconds, you will see the LED hour section blinks, then press $(-\infty)$ button to adjust the hour, after hour is set, press \triangle button to switch to minute, then press $(-\infty)$ button to adjust the minute, after minute is set, press $(-\infty)$ button to confirm setting (If no button is pressed for 15 seconds, the setting is saved automatically).

Set Alarm Volume

In Alarm setting mode, press <

Set Alarm Sound

After set the alarm minute, press Ω button two times to enter alarm tone selection, then press +/+ or +/+ button to choose the tone you want (1, 2, 3, 4 tones plus 5 FM radio tone), after tone is set, press + button to confirm setting (If no button is pressed for 15 seconds, the setting is saved automatically). When FM is set as alarm tone, press </-- or +/>> to adjust the Alarm volume.

Turn On/Off Alarm

Press \(^2\) button to turn off or turn on alarm, the LED alarm icon keeps off or on correspondingly. If no one stop the alarm, it will keep ringing for 1hrs and stop automatically.

Use Snooze Feature

- 1) To repeat alarm, when alarm rings, press <code>bimmer SNOOZE sleep</code> button to snooze for 9 mins.

 2) When alarm (normal tones) rings, press any button (expect <code>bimmer SNOOZE sleep</code> button) to stop alarm. The alarm stops, but the alarm setting remains.

 3) When alarm (FM tone) rings, press <code>44/-or +/+></code> to adjust FM volume. Therefore, press any button (expect <code>bimmer SNOOZE sleep</code> button & <code>44/-or +/+></code>) to stop alarm. The FM stops, but the alarm setting remains. setting remains.

Set the Sleep Timer

In BT/AUX/FM modes, press and hold DIMMER **SNOOZE** SLEEP button to adjust sleep timer, there are "90/60/30/15 minutes" and "OFF" total 5 options, after you get to the desired option, let go off **DIMMER SNOOZE** SLEEP button to confirm selection.

Play FM Radio

- 1) The default mode upon power on is OFF mode. Press M button to switch to FM mode. (FM supports 87.5MHz to 108MHz)
 2) Press 44/-or +/*>button to tune frequency for 0.1MHz each time, double-click 44/-or +/*>button to start auto scan, it stops until a station is found, auto scan will be interrupted by press 44/-or
- 3) Tune to the radio station you want to program, then press and hold 🔰 button for 2 seconds to enter preset mode. The next available preset number (P-01 through P-10) appears on the LED. If you want to use a different preset number, press (P-01 through P-10) and the LED if you want to use a different preset number, press (P-0 + I) button repeatedly until the number you want appears on the LED, then press | I button again to save your station and exit preset mode with "beep" voice prompt. (If no button is pressed for 15 seconds, the setting is saved
- 4) Press ▶|| button to enter play preset station mode, and the last played preset station number (P-01 through P-10) appears on the LED, then press ∢/- or +/→ button repeatedly until the preset station you want appears on the LED. Press ▶|| button again to exit play preset station
- 5) Press and hold 4/- or +/>> button to adjust volume, the volume level number appears on LED.

Adjust LED Brightness

When alarm no sounds, short press DIMMER SNOOZE SLEEP button to adjust LED brightness, there are low, medium and high three levels for selection. In power off status, the digital LED will turn into the lowest brightness (default).

Play Audio from a Bluetooth Device

The first time you connect your Bluetooth device to this player, you need to pair your device to this

 Press and hold | | | button for 3 seconds to disconnect the current connected device, clock
- radio re-enters paring status.

 3) When Bluetooth is disconnected, press >|| button and clock radio will reconnect with the device that has connected before.
- 4) Press and hold <-/-or+/>> button to adjust volume, the volume level number appears on LED.

Connect an External Audio Device

- 1) In any mode, plug an audio cable with a 3.5 mm connector (not included) into the AUX IN jack on the back of your clock radio and into the audio out jack on your audio device, clock radio enters AUX mode automatically and plays the audio from your audio device, LED AUX icon
- 2)Press and hold $\P/-$ or $+/\Longrightarrow$ button to adjust volume, the volume level number appears on LED.

Return Factory Default

Press and hold 44/—or +/>> together for 10 seconds until "beep" to return factory default. The previous Clock settings, Alarm settings and Bluetooth paring settings will be cleared.

Wireless Charging a Mobile Device

- 1) Plug in the included 9V/3A power adapter and your clock radio is powered on.
 2) Make sure your device supports Qi charging technology.
 3) Put your device horizontally on the wireless stand, DO NOT put it vertically as this will make it beyond charging arrange.
 4) Your device will show charging status if charge successfully.

Charge a Mobile Device via USB-A Port

- 1) Plug in the included 9V/3A power adapter and your clock radio is powered on.
- 2) Connect a USB cable (not provided) to the USB port on the back of your clock radio and to the USB port on your device.
 3) Your device will show charging status if charge successfully.
