

# Getting Started

Location of Controls 1. 3.5 mm Auxiliary Input Jack 2. LED Indicator 3. Micro-USB Charging Port 4. [☆] Button: Turn lights ON, cycle through lights modes, turn lights OFF 5. [Power] Switch: Power speaker ON/OFF



# Charging the Speaker

Insert the small connector of the supplied micro-USB charging cable into the micro-USB charging port on the back of the speaker. Insert the large connector into the USB port on a computer, USB charging device, or **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall outlet.

The LED indicator will *turn RED* while charging and turn off when fully charged. On low power, a tone will be heard, indicating that the speaker needs to be charged.

## Powering the Speaker

• Move the **[Power]** switch to the ON position to power the speaker on. A tone will be heard, the lights will turn on, and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode.

• Move the **[Power]** switch to the OFF position to power the speaker off.

# Using the Lights

• Press the [ \u03c6] button to cycle through the light modes. For best results with the reactive lights modes, increase the volume of your paired or connected device.

 $\bullet$  Continue to press the [  $\bigtriangledown$  ] button until the lights turn off.

# Playing Music

To listen to music on your speaker make sure it is paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device (see the **Bluetooth Pairing** section) or connected to a wired device, using the 3.5 mm auxiliary input jack (see **Connecting with a Wired Device** section).

# **Bluetooth** Pairing

1. Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard and the LED indicator will *quickly flash GREEN*.

- Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select SBT3024 from the list of found devices.
- 3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and the LED indicator will *slowly flash GREEN*.

Use the controls on your connected device for playback and volume adjustment.

# Using with a Wired Device

Insert one connector of a 3.5 mm auxiliary cable (*not included*) into the 3.5 mm auxiliary input jack on the back of the speaker. Insert the other connector into the headphone jack on your media-playing device.

Use the controls on your connected device for playback and volume adjustment.
