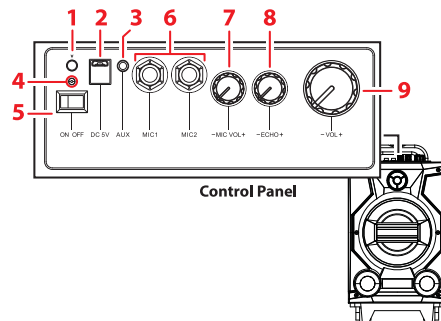

Getting Started

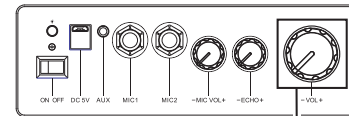
Charging the Speaker

Insert the small connector of the supplied micro-USB cable into the USB charging port on the control panel. Insert the large connector into the USB port on a computer, a USB charging device, or a **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

The LED indicator will turn **RED** while charging and turn **OFF** when fully charged. On low battery, a tone will be heard periodically indicating that the speaker needs to be charged.

Powering ON/OFF

- Move the **[Power]** switch to power the speaker ON/OFF.



Adjusting Volume

- Use the speaker volume knob to adjust volume.



Using the Lights

- Press the **[LED]** button to cycle through light modes.

Playing Music

To listen to music on the speaker, you must be paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device or connect to the 3.5 mm auxiliary input jack. Once paired, audio playback and volume adjustment can be controlled via your paired media-playing device.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard, the speaker lights will turn on, and the LED indicator will **quickly flash BLUE**.
2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **AR3045** from the list of found devices.
3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and the LED indicator will **slowly flash BLUE**.

Connecting with a Wired Device

Attach one connector of a 3.5 mm auxiliary cable (not included) to the 3.5 mm auxiliary input jack on the back of the speaker. Attach the other connector to the headphone jack on your media-playing device. The LED indicator will **turn solid BLUE**.

Use the controls on your connected device to pause/resume media playback. Volume can be adjusted with your connected device or with the volume knob on the speaker.

Using Microphones

- Insert the 1/4" connector on a microphone (not included) into one of the microphone input jacks on the control panel of the speaker.
- Adjust microphone volume with the Mic Volume knob.
 - Adjust microphone echo effect with the Echo knob.
 - To avoid microphone feedback, do not place or use the mics while in front of the speaker. When not in use, turn the mics off or turn the mic volume all the way down.
