

- When using the reactive light modes, where the lights will dance to the beat of your music, increase the volume of your paired device for best results.

- Press the [>II] button on the remote control to pause/resume media plavback.

- Press the [•×] button to mute/unmute volume.




Using the System

Powar ON/OFF

- Press the [61 button on the side of the main speaker or the remote control to power the system ON. When powered ON, the LED light panels will turn on and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode, automatically re-pairing to any nearby previouslypaired device that has Bluetooth enabled.
- · Press the [6 I button on the main speaker or the remote to power the system OFF.

Bluetooth Pairing

- 1 Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard.
- 2 Sat your mobile device to search for Bluatooth devices. Whan it appears, select BSSK9000 from the list of found devices.
- 3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard again, indicating the system is paired.



Insbilling Ramote Battari. The remote control will already have a CR2025 battery installed, just remove the plastic tab sticking out of the compartment.

To replace a battery, remove the compartment from the side of the remote control. Place a new CR2025 battery with the polarity facing up and slide the compartment beck in so that it clips into place.






The LED panel has a single position pin hale that can only be connected to a bracket h a single orientation. The Main speaker panel has a single, central position pin hole and the Secondary speaker panel has multiple position pin hales, and can be connected to the bracket in any orientation.

Note: The main speaker MUST be connected to the main speaker bracket. The bracket will be marked with a sticker.

Connecting the Speakers & Lights

Installation & Setup

Before drilling any holes, make sure that the area you plan on mounting your speaker system is near a working electrical outlet, and that you will be able to plug the adapter into the main speaker and the outlet. *Make sure that the controls on the Main speaker panel will be accessible once mounted.*


 Once you have constructed your wall brackets, place them in the location they will be mounted. Using a pencil, mark all 3 screw holes on each bracket.

Note: It is HIGHLY recommended that you use the wall brackets as a guide to mark the holes. This will ensure that there are no incorrect measurements!

 Set the wall brackets aside and, using a power drill, drill at each pencil mark.

3. Insert the supplied plastic anchors into the holes.
