

“90.203(j)(4): Applications for part 90 certification of transmitters designed to operate on frequencies in the 150.8–162.0125 MHz, 173.2–173.4 MHz, and/or 421–512 MHz bands, received on or after January 1, 2011, except for hand-held transmitters with an output power of two watts or less, will only be granted for equipment with the following channel bandwidths:...”

Equipment, FCC ID: 2AIQACVA1 is utilized as a portable (e.g. hand-held / body worn) device operating with output power less than 2 Watts.

This equipment is exempt from 6.25kHz requirement, having an output power of 1.26W and being portable equipment, consistent with the language used in and update order to this rule within FCC 05-69 (35 CR 532) relating hand-held operations with portable equipment, “For example, these frequencies may be used for voice transmissions from a portable (hand-held) unit”
