**Bluetooth Pairing**

Take out from the charging case, they will automatically power on.

Pairing Mode =

Paired = Slow Flashing Blue

**Earbud Controls**

**Left Earbud**  
Press & Hold 3 sec: ON/OFF  
Press: Play/Pause/Answer & End call  
Press 2X: Next Track  
Press 2X: Increase Volume  
Press & Hold 2 sec: Reject call/Just Ask\*

**Right Earbud**  
Press & Hold 3 sec: ON/OFF  
Press: Play/Pause/Answer & End call  
Press 2X: Previous Track  
Press 2X: Decrease Volume  
Press & Hold 2 sec: Reject call/Just Ask\*

**Reset Function:**  
1. Turn off Bluetooth device and turn off bluetooth Earbuds.  
2. Take out one earbud from charging case, the indicator light flashes red and blue alternately, and then click the button four times quickly to turn off the earbud.  
3. Take out the other earbud and repeat the step 2

\*To use Siri or Google Assistant, you must have a phone that is compatible with one of the two voice assistants (iOS or Android, respectively).

\*Your Wireless Earbuds will not work with Siri or Google Assistant if the assistant is not first enabled within the settings on the phone. For more information, see your phone's user manual.

\*You must be within Bluetooth® range to use Siri or Google Assistant via your Wireless Earbuds.

**Wearing the Ear Hooks**

Your Power Session Sport earbuds come with flexible ear hooks that offers seamless support, comfortability, and security during activities. Below is a visual depiction of how the hooks should fit.
