1.Keep the earphones away from sharp edges, uneven surfaces, metal components and anything else which could damage your earphones.


2.Do not modify, repair or disassemble your earphones without professional instruction.

5. Keep the earphones, accessories and other package contents away from children and pets to prevent accidents from happening





Charging your device



Please charge the earphones via USB charging cable, the light indicator will be red whilst charging and the indicator will turn blue once earphones are fully charged. The earphones will be fully charged within 2 hours, over charging could decrease battery life.

Instructions

Power on: Press the " " button for 3 seconds, voice prompt guides with "power on".

Power off: Press the " " button for 3 seconds again to power off, voice prompt guides with "power off".

Bluetooth paring: Long press the " " button for 10s from power off state to enter pairing mode, please connect the Bluetooth device following the Bluetooth connection instructions above. Vol+/Next Song: Short press "+" button for Vol+, long press "+" button for next song.

Vol-/Previous Song: Short press "-" button for Vol-, long press"-" button for previous song.

Answer/End call: Press the " (b) " button to answer a call, press the button again to end the call.

Reject call: Double press the " ⁽⁽⁾) " button to reject a call.

Low Battery Warning: LED light flashes red and voice prompt guides with "battery low".

Charging: Please charge with USB cable, LED light turns red when charging, turns blue when fully charged.

Bluetooth Connection

1. The earphones are universally compatible with mobile phones, tablets, PCs and other Bluetooth devices.

2. Long press the power button for 10s to power on earphones and enter pairing mode.

 Turn on the Bluetooth on your device and pair with "BTH-103". If password needed, please enter "0000".
Voice prompt will guide as "Paired" when connected successfully.
If it is not the first connection and there is a connection record. Please just power on the earphones(short press power button), it will reconnect automatically.
