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






## Receiving Pattern (Φ), θ=0°






Uncertainty of Axial Isotropy Assessment: ±1.2% (k=2)

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





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# Dynamic Range f(SAR<sub>head</sub>) (TEM cell, f = 900 MHz)



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
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#### Impedance Measurement Plot for Head TSL



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


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#### Impedance Measurement Plot for Head TSL





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




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#### Impedance Measurement Plot for Head TSL





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
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### Impedance Measurement Plot for Head TSL


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### Impedance Measurement Plot for Head TSL




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### Impedance Measurement Plot for Head TSL








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
### Impedance Measurement Plot for Head TSL
