B. Access to the required information on the e-label

1. Users can access the information in no more than three steps in a device's menu. The actual steps are:

Starting from Main Screen:


Step 1 – Connect a power source with micro USB to start charging the device's battery Step 2 – Press the [Save Button] for 2 seconds Step 3 – Press the [Save Button] once to view FCC ID

No special access codes or permissions are required to go through the above steps beyond entering a userdefined password to protect against unauthorized access to the device.

2. The information is stored on the device, no special accessories or supplemental plug-ins *(e.g., a SIM/USIM card)* are required to access the information.

3. Users are provided specific instructions on how to access the information. The information is provided on page 4 of the User Guide, of which an extracted image is inserted below.

C. Labeling for Importation and Purchasing

Products utilizing e-labels are required to have a physical label on the product at the time of importation, marketing and sales. For devices imported in bulk and not packaged individually, a removable adhesive label or, for devices in protective bags, a label on the bags is acceptable for this purpose. Any removable label shall be of a type intended to survive normal shipping and handling and must only be removed by the customer after purchase. For devices imported already in individual packages ready for sale, the information may alternatively be provided on the package. It shall contain:

1. The FCC ID and/or the DoC logo (if applicable); and

2. Any other information required by specific rule to be provided on the surface of the product unless such information is permitted to be included in the User's manual or other packaging inserts.

The only FCC ID is provided on the package.

D. Other considerations

1. The above information is programmed by the responsible party and the information is secured in such a manner that third-parties cannot modify it.

2. All the applicable regulatory information required on the packaging or user instructions is provided according to the rules even if it is displayed electronically.

3. E-label displays may include regulatory information required to be placed in the User Guide or on the packaging as required by the rules.

4. All other information that cannot be found on the label are contained in the User Guide.
