Other devices cannot be charged with the product. The product is intended for private use only and not for commercial use. 
Setting up the product with holder 🛽 (Fig B)

- Slide the holder 8 out from the back of the product.
- Insert the holder 8 through the slot 9 as far as it will go in. The curved edge must point upwards.
- Place the assembled product on a stable, level surface.


Charge your device

1. Plug the USB type A plug 4 of the USB charging cable 5 into the USB port on a suitable USB adapter (not included) and plug the USB type C plug 6 into USB type C input socket 3 of the product.





2. Plug the USB adapter (not included) into an easily accessible mains socket.



- LED indicator 2 will light up in 2 seconds when the product is under standby mode and there no mobile device on the Qi charging surface 1.
- 4. Place the mobile device on the Qi charging surface

 Make sure the center of the device is aligned over the center of the Qi charging surface. Charging will begin on contact. The LED indicator 2 lights up blue when charging is active on Qi charging surface
 Protective covers that protect the mobile device may interfere with the charging process. In this case, the

interfere with the charging process. In this case, the mobile device must be removed from the protective cover.

*(i) NOTE: The charging power is up to 10 W, depending on the power adapter used.

LED indicator 2 status

The product has a LED that indicates its operational status:

LED indicator	Status
Blue lights up 2 seconds	Starting process (Boot phase) / Standby
Blue light	Charging/ Full Charge

Troubleshooting

What should I do if the LED indicator of the product is not lit during starting process (Boot phase)?

- Check the USB cable connection between USB adapter (not included) and the product. The USB cable must be firmly connected.
- Check the connection between the mains socket and the USB adapter (not included).
- Alternatively, the user must try another mains socket.

What should I do if the mobile device does not get charging ?

Check that the mobile device have Qi wireless charging technology.

- Check the mobile device is placed horizontally on the center position of the charging pad.
- Check that no foreign object blocking the charging.
- Check whether the mobile device is removed from the protective cover.

What should I do if the LED indicator flashes blue/green?

- This indicates a fault condition occurred.
- Disconnect the USB connection immediately.
- Check that no foreign object blocking the charging.
- Let the product cool down for a while and try to use it again.

Storage when not in use

Store the product in a dry interior, away from direct sunlight, preferably in its original packaging.

Cleaning

- This product has no internal parts requiring maintenance. Moisture entering the product may result in damage.
- Ensure no moisture enters the product during cleaning to prevent damaging the product beyond repair.
- Do not use abrasive, solvent-based or aggressive cleaners. These can damage the surface of the product.

Only clean the product with a slightly damp cloth and mild washing-up liquid.

Disposal
