5 DESCRIPTION OF TEST MODES

To investigate the maximum EMI emission characteristics generates from EUT, the test system was pre-scanning tested base on the consideration of following EUT operation mode or test configuration mode which possible have effect on EMI emission level. Each of these EUT operation mode(s) or test configuration mode(s) mentioned above was evaluated respectively.

The Transmitter was operated in the normal operating mode. The TX frequency was fixed which was for the purpose of the measurements.

Test of channel included the lowest and middle and highest frequency to perform the test, then record on this report.

Those data rates (1Mbps for GFSK modulation; 2Mbps for π /4-DQPSK modulation; 3Mbps for 8DPSK modulation) were used for all test.

The EUT was pretested with 3 orientations placed on the table for the radiated emission measurement -X, Y, and Z-plane. The X-plane results were found as the worst case and were shown in this report.





7.1.4 Test Procedure

According to the requirements in Section 13.1.4.1 of ANSI C63.10-2013 Conducted emissions the EUT measured in the frequency range between 0.15 MHz and 30 MHz using CISPR Quasi-Peak and average detector mode.

- 1. The EUT was placed 0.4 meter from the conducting wall of the shielding room.
- 2. The EUT was placed on a table which is 0.8m above ground plane.
- Connect EUT to the power mains through a line impedance stabilization network (LISN). All other support equipments powered from additional LISN(s). The LISN provide 50 Ohm/ 50uH of coupling impedance for the measuring instrument.
- 4. Interconnecting cables that hang closer than 40 cm to the ground plane shall be folded back and forth in the center forming a bundle 30 to 40cm long.
- 5. I/O cables that are not connected to a peripheral shall be bundled in the center. The end of the cable may be terminated, if required, using the correct terminating impedance. The overall length shall not exceed 1 m.
- 6. LISN at least 80 cm from nearest part of EUT chassis.
- 7. The frequency range from 150KHz to 30MHz was searched.
- 8. Set the test-receiver system to Peak Detect Function and specified bandwidth(IF bandwidth=9KHz) with Maximum Hold Mode
- 9. For the actual test configuration, please refer to the related Item -EUT Test Photos.





7.2.5 Test Procedure

The test site semi-anechoic chamber has met the requirement of NSA tolerance 4 dB according to the standards: ANSI C63.10-2013. The test distance is 3m. The setup is according to the requirements in Section 13.1.4.1 of ANSI C63.10-2013 and CAN/CSA-CEI/IEC CISPR 22.

This test is required for any spurious emission that falls in a Restricted Band, as defined in Section 15.205. It must be performed with the highest gain of each type of antenna proposed for use with the EUT. Use the following spectrum analyzer settings:


(1Mbps) Channel Separation plot on channel 00-01




(1Mbps) Channel Separation plot on channel 39-40




(1Mbps) Channel Separation plot on channel 77-78




(2Mbps) Channel Separation plot on channel 00-01










Package Transfer Time Plot CH39-DH3








Package Transfer Time Plot CH39-2DH3


20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 00 (1Mbps)





20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 39 (1Mbps)













20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 39 (2Mbps)







20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 78 (2Mbps)





20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 00 (3Mbps)






Peak output Power plot on channel 00 (1Mbps)




Peak output Power plot on channel 39 (1Mbps)




Peak output Power plot on channel 78 (1Mbps)




Peak output Power plot on channel 00 (2Mbps)



Peak output Power plot on channel 39 (2Mbps)





Peak output Power plot on channel 78 (2Mbps)










Peak output Power plot on channel 39 (3Mbps)





BDR mode (GFSK): Band Edge-Low Channel




BDR mode (GFSK): Band Edge-Low Channel (Hopping Mode)
