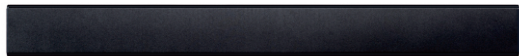

Safety precautions

- If the cord is damaged, have it repaired by the manufacturer, its service or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid any hazard.
- The cord should always be readily accessible.
- The device is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capacity. Persons who have not read the manual, unless they have received explanations by a person responsible for their safety and supervision should not use this unit.
- Children should be monitored to ensure that they do not play with the device.
- The device should always be readily accessible.
- The device should not be exposed to dripping or splashing water.
- No objects filled with liquids such as vases shall be placed on the device.
- Always leave a minimum distance of 10 cm around the unit to ensure sufficient ventilation.
- Open flame sources, such as candles, should not be placed on top of the device.
- The device is intended for use only in a temperate climate.
- At full volume, prolonged listening to the portable audio device may damage the user's hearing and cause hearing troubles (temporary or permanent deafness, hearing drone, tinnitus, hyperacusis).
So we recommend not to listen to the portable audio device at high audio volume and no more than one hour per day at medium audio volume.
- **CAUTION:** Danger of explosion if battery is incorrectly replaced or not replaced by the same type or equivalent.
- The battery should not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or similar.
- Different types of batteries, new and used batteries should not be mixed.
- The battery must be installed according to the polarity.
- If the battery is worn, it must be removed from the product.

- The battery can't be replaced by the user, but only by the maker of this product, the after sales department or a qualified person.

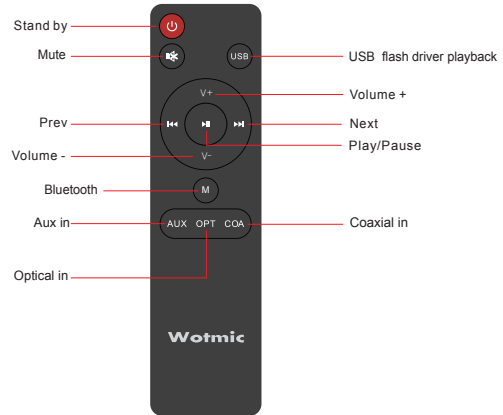
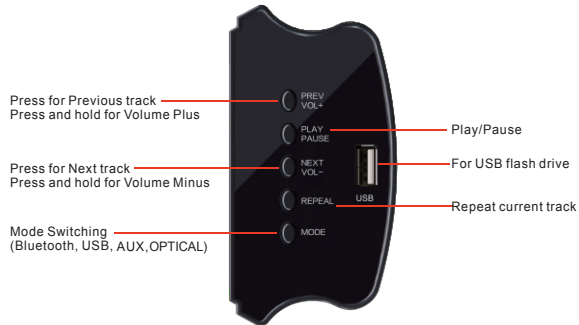

When you want to connect soundbar to your TV or other devices, Please choose output port of your devices. Please check the connection carefully before you use our products.

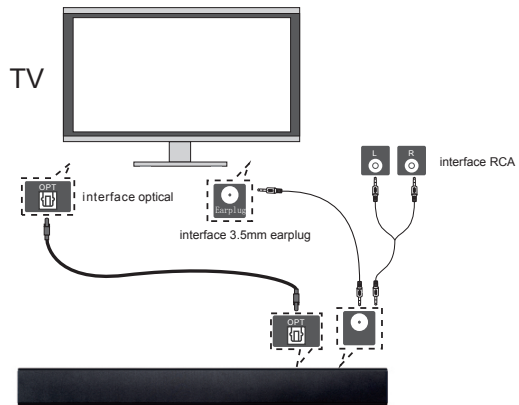
TV Connection

- Three options to connect TV and soundbar, please check your TV audio out jacks available to match soundbar audio jacks

Option 1: Use optical cable to connect TV and soundbar

Option 2: Use 3.5mm to 3.5mm audio cable to connect TV and soundbar

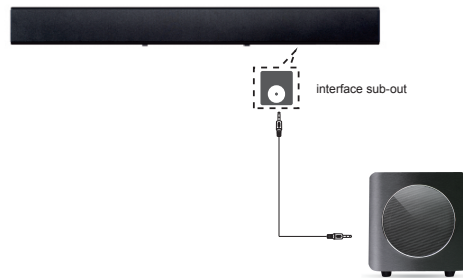
Option 3: Use RCA to 3.5mm audio cable to connect TV and soundbar

Subwoofer connection

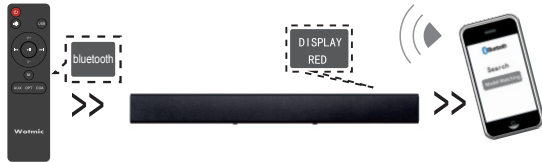
- Please note that our soundbar only support power supplied subwoofer.

Bluetooth Connection

- Press “ M ” button to enter Bluetooth Mode. Then turn on your cellphone’s Bluetooth function, search for “HIFI Speaker” and connect it.



Warnings

- To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not remove cover (or back).
- Do not expose the soundbar to dripping or splashing liquids. Do not place objects filled with liquids (such as vases) on the soundbar.
- Using the soundbar near fluorescent lighting may cause interference with the remote. If the soundbar is behaving erratically, move away from any fluorescent lighting.
- The power source must supply DC 12V --- 2A. Using a non-original adapter could damage the soundbar or adapter.

Trouble Shooting

| PROBLEM | SOLUTION |
|------------------|--|
| No sound | Make sure the AC adapter is plugged into a working outlet and firmly connected to the soundbar. Check the connection of your device to the soundbar. |
| Distorted sound | Check your source device to see if it is causing the distortion. Set the device and soundbar volume to a low level. |
| Unbalanced sound | If the volume remains low even when the soundbar’s volume is turned all the way up, check the source device to make sure it is connected via a variable output. Make sure the output is not turned down too low. |
