







HOW TO SETUP

1. Choose eartips and covers




2. Insert earbuds in your ears




HOW TO WEAR

1. Insert earbud and twist



2. Push earbud inside ear



3. Pinch flexible arms to fit



START A COACHING OR WORKOUT SESSION

Exercise with voice guided plans (COACHING) or exercise without a coach (WORKOUT)

1. Press  on right Kuai (sport)

2. Select Coaching or Workout  and press 

3. Select a Plan or Sport  and press 

4. Select Session or Intensity  and press 


5. Coaching or Training session starts. If you also want to view your live data on the phone, pair with the Kuai APP by bluetooth and press the  button.

6. Press  to Pause or Stop at any time

7. Long Press  to Save when completed


LEFT KUAI - MUSIC

TROUBLESHOOTING

Heart rate not detected or not accurate

Make sure the earbud is fully inserted in your ear and you are using the correct eartips. Follow the How to Wear instruction.

Headphone not responding

Restart the headphone pressing  on left side for 10 seconds.
