PAIRING & DISCOVERING A NEW BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

1) Power on the ATV25B by pressing and holding down the Play/Pause multifunction button for 3 seconds, the 2 blue and 3 red LEDs will start to alternately flash, signalling

NOTE: You have 2 minutes before you must restart this procedure over again

2) Now that the ATV25B is in pairing mode:

 a. Co into the Settings Menu of your device
 b. Enter the Bluetooth Menu
 c. TURN ON Bluetooth and press SCAN
 d. "BDSS AUDIO" will now be displayed under AVAILABLE DEVICES
 e. If prompled, enter passcode". "0000"

- a. Go into the Settings Menu of your iOS device b. Enter the Bluetooth Menu c. TURN ON Bluetooth d. "BOSS AUDIO" will now be displayed e. If prompted, enter passcode: "0000"

3) If the ATV25B is not seen, repeat the above steps to refresh the "Device List"

4) When the connection is successful, you are now ready to stream music from your favorite edia player to the ATV25B

BEFORE INSTALLING THIS PRODUCT



To avoid potential shorts in the electrical system, be sure to disconnect the (-) battery cable before installation. Use this unit with a 12-Volt battery and negative grounding only. Failure to do so may result in a fire or malfunction




When replacing the fuse, be sure to only use a fuse of the rating specified on this product. To avoid short-circuiting, cover any disconnected leads with insulating tape. It is especially important to insulate any unused wires, which if left uncovered rape. It is especially important to installed by unseed where, which in left uncovered may cause a short circuit. When connecting other devices to this product, refer to the manual for the product to be connected. The black cable is ground, make sure to connect the ground wire first. Ensure that the ground wire is properly connected to metal parts of the vehicles body frame or direct to the battery if your vehicle does not have a grounded chassis frame. The ground wire of this units power amp and a second powered system must be connected to the frame separately with different screws. If the screw for the ground wire loosens or falls out, it could result in fire or malfunction

1) Power on the ATV25B and your last paired device Bluetooth.

2) The unit will now automatically reconnect

3) If your device was previously paired with the ATV25B, but it wasn't the last paired

- a. Ensure no other devices are currently paired
- b. Enter the *Bluetooth Menu* on your device being paired c. "BOSS AUDIO" will display under AVAILABLE DEVICES d. Choose the "BOSS AUDIO" to reconnect

4) If the device is out of range from the ATV25B, it will disconnect automatically:

a. To reconnect once device is back in range, press the Play/Pause



b. The ATV25B will now reconnect to the device

NFC SIMPLE PAIR

NFC enabled devices tap within 1/2" of the BOSS logo, you will hear a confirmation tone your device will now automatically be paired without any further procedures, some NFC devices will require several attempts to successfully pair





MULTIFUNCTION CONTROLLER AUX-IN OPERATION

1) Power on the ATV25B by pressing and holding down the PLAY/PAUSE

multifunction button for 3 seconds

2) Disconnect any paired *Bluetooth* device by turning off *Bluetooth* in your devices Settings Menu

 Connect the integrated 3.5mm AUX-IN cable located on right side of the MFC to your devices headphone jack
4) Route the wire back to ATV25B, strap and secure your device in the supplied soft carry

VOLUME CONTROL
